~ZEMARAIM 2 (23) (Zem-a-ra'im)

- An eminence in the mountainous region of Ephraim. From this mountain, King Abijah of Judah spoke, pointing out that Jeroboam and the ten tribes of Israel had rejected Yehowah's kingdom covenant with David. Apparently, Bethel was in the same neighborhood.
- Abijah now rose up upon Mount Zemaraim, which is in the mountainous region of Ephraim, and said; Hear me, O Jeroboam and all Israel. (2 Chronicles 13:4)
- And Abijah kept chasing after Jeroboam and got to capture cities from him, Bethel and its dependent towns, and Jeshanah and its dependent towns, and Ephrain and its dependent towns. (2 Chronicles 13:19)
- Possibly Mount Zemaraim was named for the Benjamite city of Zemaraim, but the mountains precise location remains undetermined.
