

~ZIBEON (48)

(Zib'e-on) [Hyena, possibly, Small Hyena]

- A sheik in the land of Seir.
- These are the sons of Seir the Horite, the inhabitants of the land: Lotan and Shobal and **Zibeon** and Anah. (**Genesis 36:20**)
- These are the sheiks of the Horite, Sheik Lotan, Sheik Shobal, Sheik **Zibeon**, Sheik Anah. (**Genesis 36:29**)
- Sheik Dishon, Sheik Ezer, Sheik Dishan. These are the sheiks of the Horite according to their sheiks in the land of Seir. (**Genesis 36:30**)
- And the sons of Seir were Lotan and Shobal and **Zibeon** and Anah and Dishon and Ezer and Dishan. (**1 Chronicles 1:38**)
- The sons of Shobal were Alvan and Manahath and Ebal, Shepho and Onam. And the sons of **Zibeon** were Aiah and Anah. (**1 Chronicles 1:40**)
- His granddaughter Oholibamah married Esau.
- Esau took his wives from the daughters of Canaan: Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite and Oholibamah the daughter of Anah, the granddaughter of **Zibeon** the Hivite. (**Genesis 36:2**)
- And these came to be the sons of Oholibamah the daughter of Anah, the granddaughter of **Zibeon**, Esau's wife, in that she bore to Esau Jeush and Jalam and Korah. (**Genesis 36:14**)
- And these are the sons of **Zibeon**, Aiah and Anah. This is the Anah who found the hot springs in the wilderness while he was tending the asses for **Zibeon** his father. (**Genesis 36:24**)
- And these are the children of Anah, Dishon and Oholibamah the daughter of Anah. (**Genesis 36:25**)
- For the suggested explanations as to why **Zibeon** is described as both a Hivite and a Horite.
