~ZIMRAN (31) (Zim'ran)

- First named of the six sons Keturah bore to Abraham. Zimran and his five full brothers were given gifts and sent into the land of the East.
- Furthermore, Abraham again took a wife, and her name was Keturah. (Genesis 25:1)
- In time she bore him **Zimran** and Jokshan and Medan and Midian and Ishbak and Shuah. (**Genesis 25:2**)
- But to the sons of the concubines that Abraham had Abraham gave gifts. Then he sent them away from Isaac his son, while he was still alive, eastward, to the land of the East. (Genesis 25:6)
- As for the sons of Keturah, Abraham's concubine, she gave birth to Zimran and Jokshan and Medan and Midian and Ishbak and Shuah. And the sons of Jokshan were Sheba and Dedan. (1 Chronicles 1:32)
- The conjecture of some is that Zimrans descendants were associated either with Zabram, a town situated West of Mecca on the Arabian shore of the Red Sea, or with Zimri, mentioned in;
- And all the kings of **Zimri** and all the kings of Elam and all the kings of the Medes. (**Jeremiah 25:25**)
