~ZIN 1 (130)

- A wilderness through which the Israelites traveled en route to Canaan, not synonymous with the Wilderness of Sin.
- After that they pulled away from the Red Sea and took up camping in the wilderness of Sin. (Numbers 33:11)
- After that they pulled away from Ezion-geber and went camping in the wilderness of Zin, that is to say, Kadesh. (Numbers 33:36)
- In the second year after Israel's leaving Egypt, 12 Israelites spied out the Promised Land, starting out from the Wilderness of Zin. At that time the Israelites were encamped at Kadesh.
- After that they pulled away from Ezion-geber and went camping in the wilderness of Zin, that is to say, Kadesh. (Numbers 33:36)
- So they walked and came to Moses and Aaron and all the assembly of the sons of Israel in the wilderness of Paran, at Kadesh. And they came bringing back word to them and all the assembly and showing them the fruitage of the land. (Numbers 13:26)
- Later, after having wandered in the wilderness for years, the Israelites arrived at Kadesh in the Wilderness of Zin the second time. This area of the Wilderness of Zin was desolate, unsown, lacking figs, vines, pomegranates, and water.
- And the sons of Israel, the entire assembly, proceeded to come into the wilderness of Zin in the first month, and the people took up dwelling in Kadesh. It was there that Miriam died and there that she was buried. (Numbers 20:1)
- Now there proved to be no water for the assembly, and they began to congregate themselves against Moses and Aaron. (Numbers 20:2)
- And the people went quarreling with Moses and saying; If only we had expired when our brothers expired before Yehowah! (Numbers 20:3)

- And why have you men brought Yehowah's congregation into this wilderness for us and our beasts of burden to die there? (Numbers 20:4)
- And why have you conducted us up out of Egypt to bring us into this evil place? It is no place of seed and figs and vines and pomegranates, and there is no water to drink. (Numbers 20:5)
- Then Moses stripped Aaron of his garments and clothed Eleazar his son with them, after which Aaron died there on the top of the mountain. And Moses and Eleazar came on down from the mountain. (Numbers 20:28)
- And Aaron the priest proceeded to go up into Mount Hor at the order of Yehowah and to die there in the fortieth year of the going out of the sons of Israel from the land of Egypt, in the fifth month, on the first of the month. (Numbers 33:38)
- And it came about that in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first of the month, Moses spoke to the sons of Israel according to all that Yehowah had commanded him for them. (Deuteronomy 1:3)
- It was in connection with the waters of Meribah at Kadesh in the Wilderness of Zin that Moses and Aaron failed to sanctify Yehowah before the people and lost the privilege of entering the Promised Land.
- Subsequently Yehowah said to Moses; Go up into this mountain of Abarim and see the land that I shall certainly give the sons of Israel. (Numbers 27:12)
- When you have seen it, then you must be gathered to your people, yes, you, just as Aaron your brother was gathered. (Numbers 27:13)
- Inasmuch as you men rebelled against my order in the wilderness of Zin at the quarreling of the assembly, in relation to sanctifying me by the waters before their eyes. These are the waters of Meribah at Kadesh in the wilderness of Zin. (Numbers 27:14)
- Then die on the mountain into which you are going up, and be gathered to your people, just as Aaron your brother died on Mount Hor and got to be gathered to his people. (Deuteronomy

32:50)

- For the reason that you men acted undutifully toward me in the middle of the sons of Israel at the waters of Meribah of Kadesh in the wilderness of Zin, for the reason that you men did not sanctify me in the middle of the sons of Israel. (Deuteronomy 32:51)
- The Wilderness of **Zin** was alongside Edom, being immediately West of Edom, and at the Southeast extremity of Judah's assigned territory.
- And your south side must prove to be from the wilderness of Zin alongside Edom, and your south boundary must prove to be from the extremity of the Salt Sea on the east. (Numbers 34:3)
- And the lot of the tribe of the sons of Judah by their families came to be to the boundary of Edom, the wilderness of Zin, to the Negeb at its southern end. (Joshua 15:1)
- Since Kadesh was located in the wilderness areas of Zin and of Paran
- So they walked and came to Moses and Aaron and all the assembly of the sons of Israel in the wilderness of Paran, at Kadesh. And they came bringing back word to them and all the assembly and showing them the fruitage of the land. (Numbers 13:26)

- Possibly these were adjoining wilderness regions, or that of **Zin** may have been part of the more extensive Wilderness of Paran.
