

## ~ZIN 2 (20)

- Twice Zin appears without the term, **wilderness**. In these cases, it may designate a presently unidentified town in South Judah between the ascent of Akrabbim and Kadesh-barnea and from which the surrounding wilderness drew its name. Or it may mean the **Wilderness of Zin** itself.
- And your boundary must change direction from the south of the ascent of Akrabbim and cross over to **Zin**, and its termination must prove to be on the south of Kadesh-barnea, and it must go out to Hazar-addar and pass over to Azmon. (**Numbers 34:4**)
- And it went out southward to the ascent of Akrabbim and passed over to **Zin** and went up from the south to Kadesh-barnea and passed over to Hezron and went up to Addar and went around to Karka. (**Joshua 15:3**)
