~ZUR 1 (55) [Rock]

- One of the five kings of Midian at the time Israel approached the Promised Land. Zur is also called a chieftain and a head one of the clans of a paternal house, as well as a duke of Sihon.
- His daughter Cozbi was the Midianitess whom Zimri took for immoral relations and whom Phinehas slew. Zur himself was killed when the Israelites punished Midian for luring some men of Israel into immoral intercourse and false worship.
- And the Nethinim were dwelling in Ophel, and Ziha and Gishpa were over the Nethinim. (Nehemiah 11:21)
- And the overseer of the Levites in Jerusalem was Uzzi the son of Bani the son of Hashabiah the son of Mattaniah the son of Mica of the sons of Asaph, the singers, concerning the work of the house of the true God. (Nehemiah 11:22)
- For there was a commandment of the king in behalf of them, and there was a fixed provision for the singers as each day required. (Nehemiah 11:23)
- And Pethahiah the son of Meshezabel of the sons of Zerah the son of Judah was at the side of the king for every matter of the people. (Nehemiah 11:24)
- And as regards the settlements in their fields, there were some of the sons of Judah that dwelt in Kiriath-arba and its dependent towns and in Dibon and its dependent towns and in Jekabzeel and its settlements. (Nehemiah 11:25)
- Yehowah then spoke to Moses, saying; (Numbers 31:1)
- Take vengeance for the sons of Israel upon the Midianites.

 Afterward you will be gathered to your people. (Numbers 31:2)
- And they went waging war against Midian, just as Yehowah had commanded Moses, and they proceeded to kill every male.

 (Numbers 31:7)

- And they killed the kings of Midian along with the others slain, namely, Evi and Rekem and Zur and Hur and Reba, the five kings of Midian, and they killed Balaam the son of Beor with the sword. (Numbers 31:8)
- And all the cities of the tableland and all the royal realm of Sihon the king of the Amorites, who reigned in Heshbon, and whom Moses struck, together with the chieftains of Midian, Evi and Rekem and Zur and Hur and Reba, the dukes of Sihon, who were dwelling in the land. (Joshua 13:21)
