

**~ Egyptian (23)**

**Genesis 16:1..** Now Sarai Abram's wife had borne him no children but **she had an Egyptian maidservant and her name was Hagar**

**Genesis 16:3..** Then Sarai Abram's wife **took Hagar her Egyptian maidservant at the end of ten years of Abram's dwelling in the land of Canaan and gave her to Abram her husband as his wife**

**Genesis 21:9.** And Sarah kept noticing the son **of Hagar the Egyptian whom she had borne to Abraham** poking fun

**Genesis 25:12.** And this is the history of Ishmael the son of Abraham **whom Hagar the Egyptian the maidservant of Sarah bore to Abraham**

**Genesis 39:1.** As for Joseph he was brought down to Egypt and Potiphar a court official of Pharaoh the chief of **the bodyguard an Egyptian got to buy him from** the hand of the Ishmaelites who had brought him down there

**Genesis 39:2.** But Yehowah proved to be with Joseph so that he turned out a successful man and came to be over the house **of his master the Egyptian**

**Genesis 39:5.** And it followed that from the time he appointed him over his house and in charge of all that was his Yehowah kept blessing the **house of the Egyptian due to Joseph and Yehowahs** blessing came to be upon all that he had in the house and in the field

**Exodus 1:19..** In turn the midwives said to Pharaoh **Because the Hebrew women are not like the Egyptian women Because they are lively they have already given birth before the midwife can come in to them**

Exodus 2:11. Now it came about in those days as Moses was becoming strong that he went out to his brothers that he might look at the burdens they were bearing and he caught sight of a certain Egyptian striking a certain Hebrew of his brothers

Exodus 2:12. So he turned this way and that and saw there was nobody in sight Then he struck the Egyptian down and hid him in the sand

Exodus 2:14. At this he said Who appointed you as a prince and judge over us Are you intending to kill me just as you killed the Egyptian Moses now got afraid and said Surely the thing has become known

Exodus 2:19. To this they said A certain Egyptian delivered us out of the hand of the shepherds and besides he actually drew water for us that he might water the flock

Leviticus 24:10.. Now a son of an Israelite woman who however was the son of an Egyptian man went out into the midst of the sons of Israel and the son of the Israelitess and an Israelite man began to struggle with each other in the camp

Deuteronomy 23:7.. You must not detest an Edomite for he is your brother You must not detest an Egyptian for you became an alien resident in his country

1 Samuel 30:11.. And they got to find a man an Egyptian in the field So they took him to David and gave him bread that he might eat and gave him water to drink

1 Samuel 30:13. David now said to him To whom do you belong and where are you from to which he said I am an Egyptian attendant a slave of an Amalekite man but my master left me because I took sick three days ago

2 Samuel 23:21.. And he it was that struck down the Egyptian man that was of extraordinary size Though there was a spear in the hand of

**the Egyptian yet he went on down to him with a rod and snatched the spear away from the Egyptian's hand and killed him with his own spear**

**1 Chronicles 2:34..** And Sheshan came to have no sons but daughters  
**Now Sheshan had an Egyptian servant whose name was Jarha**

**1 Chronicles 11:23.** And he it was that **struck down the Egyptian man a man of extraordinary** size of five cubits And in the hand of the Egyptian there was a spear like the beam of loom workers yet he went on down to him with a rod and snatched the spear away from the Egyptian's hand and killed him with his own spear

**Isaiah 11:15..** And Yehowah will certainly cut off the **tongue of the Egyptian sea and wave his hand** at the River in the glow of his spirit And he must strike it in its seven torrents and he will actually cause people to walk in their sandals

**Acts of Apostles 7:24..** And when he caught sight of a certain one being unjustly treated he defended him and executed vengeance for the one being abused **by striking the Egyptian down**

**Acts of Apostles 7:28.** You do not want to do away with me in the same manner that you did **away with the Egyptian yesterday do you**

**Acts of Apostles 21:38.** Are you **not really the Egyptian who before these days stirred** up a sedition and led the four thousand dagger men out into the wilderness
