1 Samuel 1:3.. And that man went up out of his city from year to year to prostrate himself and to sacrifice to Yehowah of armies in Shiloh And there is where the **two sons of Eli Hophni and Phinehas were priests** to Yehowah

1 Samuel 1:9.. Then Hannah got up after they had eaten in Shiloh and after **the drinking while Eli the priest was sitting upon the seat by the doorpost of the temple of Yehowah**

1 Samuel 1:12. And it occurred that while she prayed **extendedly before Yehowah Eli was watching her mouth**

1 Samuel 1:13. As for Hannah she was speaking in her heart only her lips were quivering and her voice was **not heard But Eli took her for drunk**

1 Samuel 1:14. **So Eli said to her How long will you behave drunk Put away your wine from upon you**

1 Samuel 1:17. **Then Eli answered and said Go in peace and may the God of Israel grant your petition that you have asked of him**

1 Samuel 1:25. Then they slaughtered the bull and **brought the boy to Eli**

1 Samuel 2:11. Then Elkanah went to Ramah to his house and as for the boy he became a minister **of Yehowah before Eli the priest**

1 Samuel 2:12. Now **the sons of Eli were good-for-nothing men they did not acknowledge Yehowah**

1 Samuel 2:20. **And Eli blessed Elkanah and his wife and said May Yehowah appoint to you an offspring from this wife in place of**

the thing lent that was lent to Yehowah And they went to their place

1 Samuel 2:22, **And Eli was very old and he had heard of all that his sons kept doing to all Israel and how they would lie down with the women that were serving at the entrance of the tent of meeting**

1 Samuel 2:27, **And a man of God proceeded to come to Eli and say to him This is what Yehowah has said Did I not for a fact reveal myself to the house of your forefather while they happened to be in Egypt as slaves to the house of Pharaoh**

1 Samuel 3:1, **All the while the boy Samuel was ministering to Yehowah before Eli and word from Yehowah had become rare in those days there was no vision being spread abroad**

1 Samuel 3:2, **Now it came about on that day that Eli was lying in his place and his eyes had begun to grow dim he was not able to see**

1 Samuel 3:5, **And he went running to Eli and saying Here I am for you called me But he said I did not call Lie down again So he went and lay down**

1 Samuel 3:6, **And Yehowah went on to call yet again Samuel At this Samuel got up and went to Eli and said Here I am for you did call me But he said I did not call my son Lie down again**

1 Samuel 3:8, **So Yehowah called again for the third time Samuel At that he got up and went to Eli and said Here I am for you must have called me And Eli began to discern that it was Yehowah that was calling the boy**

1 Samuel 3:9, **Consequently Eli said to Samuel Go lie down and it must occur that if he should call you you must say Speak Yehowah for your servant is listening So Samuel went and lay down in his place**

- 1 Samuel 3:12, **On that day I shall carry out toward Eli all that I have said respecting his house from beginning to end**
- 1 Samuel 3:14, **And that is why I have sworn to the house of Eli that the error of the house of Eli will not be brought to exemption from punishment by sacrifice or by offering to time indefinite**
- 1 Samuel 3:15, **And Samuel continued lying down until the morning Then he opened the doors of Yehowah's house And Samuel was afraid to tell Eli of the appearing**
- 1 Samuel 3:16, **But Eli called Samuel and said Samuel my son At this he said Here I am**
- 1 Samuel 4:4, **So the people sent to Shiloh and carried from there the ark of the covenant of Yehowah of armies who is sitting upon the cherubs And the two sons of Eli were there with the ark of the covenant of the true God namely Hophni and Phinehas**
- 1 Samuel 4:11, **And the ark of God itself was captured and the two sons of Eli Hophni and Phinehas died**
- 1 Samuel 4:13, **When he arrived there was Eli sitting on the seat by the roadside watching because his heart had become atremble over the ark of the true God And the man himself went in to report in the city and the whole city began crying out**
- 1 Samuel 4:14, **And Eli got to hear the sound of the outcry So he said What does the sound of this turmoil mean And the man himself hurried that he might go in and report to Eli**
- 1 Samuel 4:15, **Now Eli was ninety-eight years old and his eyes had set so that he was unable to see**
- 1 Samuel 4:16, **And the man proceeded to say to Eli I am the one coming from the battle line and I it is from the battle line that I have fled today At this he said What is the thing that has happened my son**

1 Samuel 14:3. And Ahijah the son of Ahitub the brother of Ichabod the son of Phinehas **the son of Eli the priest of Yehowah in Shiloh** was carrying the ephod And the people themselves did not know that Jonathan had gone

1 Kings 2:27.. So Solomon drove out Abiathar from serving as a priest of Yehowah to fulfill Yehowah's word that he had spoken against **the house of Eli in Shiloh**

Matthew 27:46.. About the ninth hour Jesus called out with a **loud voice** saying **Eli Eli lama sabachthani that is** My God my God why have you forsaken me

Mark 15:34.. And at the ninth hour Jesus called out with a **loud voice** **Eli Eli lama sabachthani which means** when translated My God my God why have you forsaken me
