

~ Elijah (91) `

- 1 Kings 17:1`** **And Elijah the Tishbite from the inhabitants of Gilead** proceeded to say to Ahab **As Yehowah the God of Israel before whom I do stand is living there will occur during these years neither dew nor rain except at the order of my word**
- 1 Kings 17:13..** **Then Elijah said to her Do not be afraid Go in do** according to your word **Only from what is there make me a small round cake first and you must bring it out to me and for yourself and your son you can make something afterward**
- 1 Kings 17:16.** **The large jar of flour itself did not get exhausted and the small jar of oil itself did not fail according to Yehowah's word that he had spoken by means of Elijah**
- 1 Kings 17:18.** **At this she said to Elijah What do I have to do with you O man of the true God You have come to me to bring my error to mind and to put my son to death**
- 1 Kings 17:23.** **Elijah now took the child and brought him down from the roof chamber into the house and gave him to his mother and Elijah then said See your son is alive**
- 1 Kings 17:24.** **Upon that the woman said to Elijah Now indeed I do know that you are a man of God and that Yehowah's word in your mouth is true**
- 1 Kings 18:1`** **And it came about after many days that Yehowah's own word came to Elijah in the third year saying Go show yourself to Ahab as I am determined to give rain upon the surface of the ground**
- 1 Kings 18:2.** **Accordingly Elijah went to show himself to Ahab while the famine was severe in Samaria**

- 1 Kings 18:7. **As Obadiah continued on the way why there was Elijah to meet him At once he recognized him and fell upon his face and said Is this you my lord Elijah**
- 1 Kings 18:8. **At this he said to him It is I Go say to your lord Here is Elijah**
- 1 Kings 18:11. **And now you are saying Go say to your lord Here is Elijah**
- 1 Kings 18:14. **And now you are saying Go say to your lord Here is Elijah And he will be bound to kill me**
- 1 Kings 18:15. **However Elijah said As Yehowah of armies before whom I do stand is living today I shall show myself to him**
- 1 Kings 18:16. **Accordingly Obadiah went off to meet Ahab and told him and so Ahab went to meet Elijah**
- 1 Kings 18:17. **And it came about that as soon as Ahab saw Elijah Ahab immediately said to him Is this you the bringer of ostracism upon Israel**
- 1 Kings 18:21. **Then Elijah approached all the people and said How long will YOU be limping upon two different opinions If Yehowah is the true God go following him but if Baal is go following him And the people did not say a word in answer to him**
- 1 Kings 18:22. **And Elijah went on to say to the people I myself have been left as a prophet of Yehowah I alone while the prophets of Baal are four hundred and fifty men**
- 1 Kings 18:25. **Elijah now said to the prophets of Baal Choose for yourselves one young bull and dress it first because YOU are the majority and call upon the name of YOUR god but YOU must not put fire to it**
- 1 Kings 18:27. **And it came about at noon that Elijah began to mock them and say Call at the top of YOUR voice for he is a god for he must**

be concerned with a matter and he has excrement and has to go to the privy Or maybe he is asleep and ought to wake up

1 Kings 18:30. **At length Elijah said to all the people** Approach me So all the people approached him Then he proceeded to mend the altar of Yehowah that was torn down

1 Kings 18:31. **So Elijah took twelve stones according to** the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob to whom Yehowah's word had come saying Israel is what your name will become

1 Kings 18:36. **And it came about at the time that the grain offering goes up that Elijah the prophet began to approach** and say O Yehowah the God of Abraham Isaac and Israel today let it be known that you are God in Israel and I am your servant and it is by your word that I have done all these things

1 Kings 18:40. **Then Elijah said to them Seize the** prophets of Baal Do not let a single one of them escape At once they seized them and Elijah then brought them down to the torrent valley of Kishon and slaughtered them there

1 Kings 18:41. **Elijah now said to Ahab Go up** eat and drink for there is the sound of the turmoil of a downpour

1 Kings 18:42. **And Ahab proceeded to go up to eat and drink As for Elijah he went up to the** top of Carmel and began crouching to the earth and keeping his face put between his knees

1 Kings 18:46. **And the very hand of Yehowah proved to be upon Elijah so that he girded up** his hips and went running ahead of Ahab all the way to Jezreel

1 Kings 19:1. **Then Ahab told Jezebel all that Elijah had done and all about** how he had killed all the prophets with the sword

- 1 Kings 19:2. **At that Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah saying So may the gods do and so may they add to it if at this time tomorrow I shall not make your soul like the soul of each one of them**
- 1 Kings 19:9. **There he finally entered into a cave that he might spend the night there and look there was Yehowah's word for him and it went on to say to him What is your business here Elijah**
- 1 Kings 19:13. **And it came about that as soon as Elijah heard it he immediately wrapped his face in his official garment and went out and stood at the entrance of the cave and look there was a voice for him and it proceeded to say to him What is your business here Elijah**
- 1 Kings 19:19. **Accordingly he went from there and found Elisha the son of Shaphat while he was plowing with twelve spans before him and he with the twelfth So Elijah crossed over to him and threw his official garment upon him**
- 1 Kings 19:20. **At that he left the bulls and went running after Elijah and said Let me please kiss my father and my mother Then I will go following you At this he said to him Go return for what have I done to you**
- 1 Kings 19:21. **So he returned from following him and then took a span of the bulls and sacrificed them and with the implements of the bulls he boiled their flesh and then gave it to the people and they proceeded to eat After that he rose up and went following Elijah and began to minister to him**
- 1 Kings 21:17. **And Yehowah's word came to Elijah the Tishbite saying**
- 1 Kings 21:20. **And Ahab proceeded to say to Elijah Have you found me O enemy of mine to which he said I have found you For the reason that you have sold yourself to do what is bad in the eyes of Yehowah**
- 1 Kings 21:28. **And Yehowah's word came to Elijah the Tishbite saying**

- 2 Kings 1:3.** As for the angel of Yehowah **he spoke to Elijah the Tishbite Rise up go up to meet the messengers of the king of Samaria and say to them Is it because there is no God at all in Israel that YOU are going to inquire of Baal-zebub the god of Ekron**
- 2 Kings 1:4.** So therefore this is what Yehowah has said As regards the couch upon which you have gone up you will not come down off it because you will positively **die With that Elijah went off**
- 2 Kings 1:8.** So they said to him A man possessing a hair garment with a leather belt girded about his loins Immediately he **said It was Elijah the Tishbite**
- 2 Kings 1:10.** **But Elijah answered and spoke to the chief of the fifty Well if I am a man of God let fire come down from the heavens and eat up you and your fifty And fire came descending from the heavens and went eating up him and his fifty**
- 2 Kings 1:12.** **But Elijah answered and spoke to them If I am a man of the true God let fire come down from the heavens and eat up you and your fifty And fire of God came descending from the heavens and went eating up him and his fifty**
- 2 Kings 1:13.** And he went sending again a third chief of fifty and his fifty But the third chief of fifty went up and came and bent down upon his knees **in front of Elijah and began to implore favor of him and speak to him Man of the true God please let my soul and the soul of these fifty servants of yours be precious in your eyes**
- 2 Kings 1:15.** At that the angel **of Yehowah spoke to Elijah Go down with him Do not be afraid because of him So he rose and went down with him to the king**
- 2 Kings 1:17.** And he gradually died according to the word **of Yehowah that Elijah had spoken and Jehoram began to reign in place of him in the second year of Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah because he had not come to have a son**

- 2 Kings 2:1. **And it came about that when Yehowah was to take Elijah in a windstorm up to the heavens Elijah and Elisha proceeded to go from Gilgal**
- 2 Kings 2:2. **And Elijah began to say to Elisha Sit here please because Yehowah himself has sent me clear to Bethel But Elisha said As Yehowah is living and as your soul is living I will not leave you So they went down to Bethel**
- 2 Kings 2:4. **Elijah now said to him Elisha sit here please because Yehowah himself has sent me to Jericho But he said As Yehowah is living and as your soul is living I will not leave you So they came on to Jericho**
- 2 Kings 2:6. **Elijah now said to him Sit here please because Yehowah himself has sent me to the Jordan But he said As Yehowah is living and as your soul is living I will not leave you So both of them went on**
- 2 Kings 2:8. **Then Elijah took his official garment and wrapped it up and struck the waters and gradually they were divided this way and that way so that both of them went across on the dry ground**
- 2 Kings 2:9. **And it came about that as soon as they had gone across Elijah himself said to Elisha Ask what I should do for you before I am taken from you To this Elisha said Please that two parts in your spirit may come to me**
- 2 Kings 2:11. **And it came about that as they were walking along speaking as they walked why look a fiery war chariot and fiery horses and they proceeded to make a separation between them both and Elijah went ascending in the windstorm to the heavens**
- 2 Kings 2:13. **After that he picked up the official garment of Elijah that had fallen off him and went back and stood by the shore of the Jordan**

- 2 Kings 2:14. Then he took the **official garment of Elijah that had fallen off him** and struck the waters and said Where is Yehowah the God of Elijah even He When he struck the waters then they were gradually divided this way and that way so that Elisha went across
- 2 Kings 2:15. When the sons of the prophets that were at Jericho saw him some way off they began to say **The spirit of Elijah has settled down upon Elisha** Accordingly they came to meet him and bowed down to him to the earth
- 2 Kings 3:11. At that Jehoshaphat said Is there not here a prophet of Yehowah Then let us inquire of Yehowah through him So one of the servants of the king of Israel answered and said There is here Elisha the son of Shaphat who poured out water **upon the hands of Elijah**
- 2 Kings 9:36. When they returned and told him he went on to say It is the word of Yehowah that he spoke by means **of his servant Elijah the Tishbite saying In the tract of land of Jezreel the dogs will eat the flesh of Jezebel**
- 2 Kings 10:10. Know then that nothing of Yehowah's word will fall unfulfilled to the earth that Yehowah has spoken against the house of Ahab and Yehowah himself has done what he spoke by **means of his servant Elijah**
- 2 Kings 10:17. Finally he came to Samaria Now he went striking down all who were left over of Ahab's in Samaria until he had annihilated them according to Yehowah's word that **he had spoken to Elijah**
- 1 Chronicles 8:27.. **and Jareshiah and Elijah and Zichri the sons of Jeroham**
- 2 Chronicles 21:12.. Eventually there came a writing **to him from Elijah the prophet saying This is what Yehowah the God of David your forefather has said Due to the fact that you have not walked in**

the ways of Jehoshaphat your father or in the ways of Asa the king of Judah

Ezra 10:21.. and of the sons of Harim Maaseiah and Elijah and Shemaiah and Jehiel and Uzziah

Ezra 10:26. and of the sons of Elam Mattaniah Zechariah and Jehiel and Abdi and Jeremoth and Elijah

Malachi 4:5.. Look I am sending to YOU people Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and fear-inspiring day of Yehowah

Matthew 11:14.. and if YOU want to accept it He himself is Elijah who is destined to come

Matthew 16:14. They said Some say John the Baptist others Elijah still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets

Matthew 17:3. And look there appeared to them Moses and Elijah conversing with him

Matthew 17:4. Responsively Peter said to Jesus Lord it is fine for us to be here If you wish I will erect three tents here one for you and one for Moses and one for Elijah

Matthew 17:10. However the disciples put the question to him Why then do the scribes say that Elijah must come first

Matthew 17:11. In reply he said Elijah indeed is coming and will restore all things

Matthew 17:12. However I say to YOU that Elijah has already come and they did not recognize him but did with him the things they wanted In this way also the Son of man is destined to suffer at their hands

Matthew 27:47. At hearing this some of those standing there began to say This man is calling Elijah

Matthew 27:49. **But the rest of them said Let him be Let us see whether Elijah comes to save him Another man took a spear and pierced his side and blood and water came out**

Mark 6:15.. **But others were saying It is Elijah Still others were saying It is a prophet like one of the prophets**

Mark 8:28. **They said to him John the Baptist and others Elijah still others One of the prophets**

Mark 9:4. **Also Elijah with Moses appeared to them and they were conversing with Jesus**

Mark 9:5. **And responsively Peter said to Jesus Rabbi it is fine for us to be here so let us erect three tents one for you and one for Moses and one for Elijah**

Mark 9:11. **And they began to question him saying Why do the scribes say that first Elijah must come**

Mark 9:12. **He said to them Elijah does come first and restore all things but how is it that it is written respecting the Son of man that he must undergo many sufferings and be treated as of no account**

Mark 9:13. **But I say to YOU Elijah in fact has come and they did to him as many things as they wanted just as it is written respecting him**

Mark 15:35. **And some of those standing near on hearing it began to say See He is calling Elijah**

Mark 15:36. **But a certain one ran soaked a sponge with sour wine put it on a reed and began giving him a drink saying LET him be Let us see whether Elijah comes to take him down**

Luke 4:25.. For instance I tell YOU in truth There were many widows in Israel in **the days of Elijah when the heaven was shut** up three years and six months so that a great famine fell upon all the land

Luke 4:26. **yet Elijah was sent to none of** those women but only to Zarephath in the land of Sidon to a widow

Luke 9:8. **but by others that Elijah had appeared but by still** others that a certain one of the ancient prophets had risen

Luke 9:19. In reply they said John the **Baptist but others Elijah and still others that one** of the ancient prophets has risen

Luke 9:30. Also look two men were conversing with him **who were Moses and Elijah**

Luke 9:33. And as these were being separated from him Peter said to Jesus Instructor it is fine for us to be here so let us erect three tents one for you and one for **Moses and one for Elijah** he not realizing what he was saying

John 1:21.. And they asked him **What then Are you Elijah** And he said I am not Are you The Prophet And he answered No

John 1:25. So they questioned him and said to him Why then do you baptize if you yourself are not **the Christ or Elijah or The Prophet**

Romans 11:2.. God did not reject his people whom he first recognized Why do YOU not know what the Scripture says **in connection with Elijah as he pleads with God** against Israel

James 5:17.. **Elijah was a man with feelings** like ours and yet in prayer he prayed for it not to rain and it did not rain upon the land for three years and six months
