

**2 Samuel 11:11** At this Uriah said to David; The Ark and Israel and Judah are dwelling in booths, and my lord Joab and the servants of my lord are camping on the face of the field, and I, shall I go into my own house to eat and drink and to lie down with my wife? As you are living and as your soul is living, I shall not do this thing!

- So they brought the ark of Yehowah in and set it in its place inside the tent that **David** had pitched for it, after which **David** offered up burnt sacrifices and communion sacrifices before Yehowah. (**2 Samuel 6:17**)
- Then the king **said** to Nathan the prophet; See, now, I am **dwelling** in a **house** of cedars while the ark of the true God is **dwelling** in the middle of tent cloths. (**2 Samuel 7:2**)
- Then **David said** to Abishai; Now Sheba the son of Bichri will be worse for us than Absalom. You yourself take the **servants** of your **lord** and chase after him, that he may not actually find for himself fortified cities and escape before our eyes. (**2 Samuel 20:6**)
- Now in case a man has an emission of semen **go** out from him, he must then bathe all his flesh in water and be unclean until the evening. (**Leviticus 15:16**)
- In case you **go** out into camp against your enemies, you must also keep yourself from every bad thing. (**Deuteronomy 23:9**)
- So **David** answered the priest and **said** to him; But womankind has been kept away from us the same as formerly when I went out, and the organisms of the young men continue holy, although the mission itself is ordinary. And how much more so today, when one becomes holy in his organism? (**1 Samuel 21:5**)
- Now at the moment that Saul saw **David** going out to meet the Philistine, he **said** to Abner the chief of the army; Whose son is the boy, Abner? To this Abner **said**; By the life of your **soul**, O king, I do not know at all! (**1 Samuel 17:55**)
- But **David** swore in addition and **said**; Your father must surely know that I have found favor in your eyes, and so would say; Do not let Jonathan know this for fear he may feel hurt. But, in fact,

- as Yehowah is **living** and as your **soul is living**, there is just about a step between me and death! (**1 Samuel 20:3**)
- **And now, my lord**, as Yehowah is **living** and as your **soul is living**, Yehowah has held you back from entering into bloodguilt and having your **own** hand come to your salvation. And now let your enemies and those seeking injury to my **lord** become like Nabal. (**1 Samuel 25:26**)
  - And the king went on to say; Is the hand of **Joab** with you in all this? Then the woman answered and **said**; As your **soul is living**, O my **lord** the king, no man can **go** to the right or **go** to the left from all that my **lord** the king has spoken, for it was your servant **Joab** that commanded me, and he it was that put in the mouth of your maidservant all these words. (**2 Samuel 14:19**)
  - With that she **said**; Excuse me, my **lord**! By the life of your **soul**, my **lord**, I am the woman that was standing with you in this place to pray to Yehowah. (**1 Samuel 1:26**)
  - But the priest answered **David** and **said**; There is no ordinary bread under my hand, but there is holy bread, provided that the young men have at least kept themselves from womankind. (**1 Samuel 21:4**)
