- Consequently let him that thinks he is standing beware that he does not fall. (**1 Corinthians 10:12**)
- But each one is tried by being drawn out and enticed by his own desire. (**James 1:14**)
- And David began to comfort Bath-sheba his wife. Further, he came in to her and lay down with her. In time she bore a son, and his name came to be called Solomon. And Yehowah himself did love him. (**2 Samuel 12:24**)
- Nathan now said to Bath-sheba, Solomon's mother; Have you not heard that Adonijah the son of Haggith has become king, and our lord David does not know of it at all? (**1 Kings 1:11**)
- And there were these born to him in Jerusalem; Shimea and Shobab and Nathan and Solomon, four of Bath-sheba the daughter of Ammiel. (**1 Chronicles 3:5**)
- Uriah the Hittite, thirty-seven in all. (**2 Samuel 23:39**)
- Because David did what was right in the eyes of Yehowah, and he did not turn aside from anything that He had commanded him all the days of his life, only in the matter of Uriah the Hittite. (**1 Kings 15:5**)
- Uriah the Hittite, Zabad the son of Ahlai. (**1 Chronicles 11:41**)
- And Canaan became father to Sidon his firstborn and Heth. (**Genesis 10:15**)
- And the Hittites and the Perizzites and the Rephaim. (**Genesis 15:20**)
- Because you should without fail devote them to destruction, the Hittites and the Amorites, the Canaanites and the Perizzites, the Hivites and the Jebusites, just as Yehowah your God has commanded you. (**Deuteronomy 20:17**)

- **Neither must you desire your fellowman's wife. Neither must you selfishly crave your fellowman's house, his field or his slave man or his slave girl, his bull or his ass or anything that belongs to your fellowman. (Deuteronomy 5:21)**
- **Who was it that struck down Abimelech the son of Jerubbesheth? Was it not a woman that pitched an upper millstone upon him from on top of the wall so that he died at Thebez? Why did you men have to go so close to the wall? you must also say; Your servant Uriah the Hittite died too. (2 Samuel 11:21)**
- **But the man of little means had nothing but one female lamb, a small one, that he had bought. And he was preserving it alive, and it was growing up with him and with his sons, all together. From his morsel it would eat, and from his cup it would drink, and in his bosom it would lie, and it came to be as a daughter to him. (2 Samuel 12:3)**
