- Meantime Boaz ate and drank, and his **heart** was feeling good. Then he went to lie **down** at the extremity of the grain heap. After that she came stealthily and uncovered him at his feet and lay **down**. (**Ruth 3:7**)
- Later Abigail came in to Nabal, and there he was having a feast in his house like the feast of the king, and Nabal's **heart** was feeling good within him, and he was as drunk as could be, and she did not tell him a thing, small or great, until the morning light. (**1 Samuel 25:36**)
- On the seventh day, when the king's **heart** was in a **merry mood** with **wine**, he said to Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona, Bigtha and Abagtha, Zethar and Carkas, the seven court officials that were ministering to the person of King Ahasuerus. (**Esther 1:10**)
- And **wine** that makes the **heart** of mortal man rejoice, to make the face shine with oil, and bread that sustains the very **heart** of mortal man. (**Psalms 104:15**)
- I explored with my **heart** by cheering my flesh even with **wine**, while I was leading my **heart** with wisdom, even to lay hold on folly until I could see what good there was to the sons of mankind in what they did under the heavens for the number of the days of their life. (**Ecclesiastes 2:3**)
- Bread is for the laughter of the workers, and **wine** itself makes life rejoice, but money is what meets a response in all things. (**Ecclesiastes 10:19**)
- Immediately Saul swore to her by Yehowah, **saying**; As Yehowah is alive, guilt for error will not befall you in this matter! (**1 Samuel 28:10**)

- **But the king said to her; Do not be afraid, but what did you see? And the woman went on to say to Saul; A god I saw coming up out of the earth. (1 Samuel 28:13)**
- **And it came about that because their heart was merry, they began to say; Call Samson that he may offer us some amusement. So they called Samson out of the prison house that he might make sport before them, and they proceeded to stand him between the pillars. (Judges 16:25)**
- **Absalom now sent spies through all the tribes of Israel, saying; As soon as you hear the sound of the horn, you must also say; Absalom has become king in Hebron! (2 Samuel 15:10)**
- **The third, Absalom the son of Maacah the daughter of Talmai the king of Geshur, the fourth, Adonijah the son of Haggith. (1 Chronicles 3:2)**
