- And the counsel of **Ahithophel**, with which he counseled in those days, was just as when a man would inquire of the word of the true God. That was the way all the counsel of **Ahithophel** was both to David and to **Absalom**. (**2 Samuel 16:23**)
- Then **Absalom** and all the men of Israel said; The counsel of Hushai the Archite is better than the counsel of Ahithophel! And Yehowah himself had given command to frustrate the counsel of **Ahithophel** although good, in order that Yehowah might bring calamity upon **Absalom**. (**2 Samuel 17:14**)
- Eliphelet the son of Ahasbai the son of the Maacathite, Eliam the son of **Ahithophel** the **Gilonite**. (**2 Samuel 23:34**)
- Also the man at peace with me, in whom I trusted, who was eating my bread, has magnified his heel against me. (**Psalms 41:9**)
- But it was you, a mortal man who was as my equal, one familiar to me and my acquaintance. (**Psalms 55:13**)
- Do not put **YOUR** faith in a companion. Do not put **YOUR** trust in a confidential friend. From her who is lying in your bosom guard the openings of your mouth. (**Micah 7:5**)
- I am not talking about all of **you**, I know the ones I have chosen. But it is in order that the Scripture might be fulfilled; He that used to feed on my bread has lifted up his heel against me. (**John 13:18**)
- And Goshen and Holon and **Giloh**, eleven cities and their settlements. (**Joshua 15:51**)
- However, his servants rose up and leagued together in a **conspiracy** and struck Jehoash down at the house of the Mound, on the way that goes down to Silla. (**2 Kings 12:20**)

- However, the king of Assyria got to find **conspiracy** in Hoshea's case, in that he had **sent** messengers to So the king of Egypt and did not bring the tribute up to the king of Assyria as in former years. Hence the king of Assyria shut him up and **kept** him bound in the house of detention. (**2 Kings 17:4**)
- And from the time that Amaziah turned aside from following Yehowah, they proceeded to form a **conspiracy** against him in Jerusalem. At length he fled to Lachish, but they **sent** after him to Lachish and put him to death there. (**2 Chronicles 25:27**)
- O Yehowah, why have my adversaries become many? Why are many rising up against me? (**Psalms 3:1**)
- Judge me, O God, and do conduct my legal case against a nation not loyal. From the man of deception and unrighteousness may you provide me with escape. (**Psalms 43:1**)
- My son, fear Yehowah and the king. With those who are for a change, do not intermeddle. (**Proverbs 24:21**)
- And his second was Chileab by Abigail the wife of Nabal the Carmelite, and the third was **Absalom** the son of Maacah the daughter of Talmai the king of Geshur. (**2 Samuel 3:3**)
- As for **Absalom** and all the **people**, the men of Israel, they entered Jerusalem, and **Ahithophel** was with him. (**2 Samuel 16:15**)
- As for **Ahithophel**, he saw that his counsel had not been acted upon, and he proceeded to saddle an ass and rise up and go off to his house at his own **city**. Then he gave commands to his household and strangled himself and thus died. So he was buried in the burial place of his forefathers. (**2 Samuel 17:23**)
- As for **Absalom**, whom we anointed over us, he has died in the battle. So now why are **YOU** doing nothing to bring the king back? (**2 Samuel 19:10**)
- At that all the men of Israel began to go up from following David to follow Sheba the son of Bichri, but as for the men of Judah, they stuck to their king from the Jordan to Jerusalem. (**2 Samuel 20:2**)
- Then David said to Abishai; Now Sheba the son of Bichri will be worse for us than **Absalom**. You yourself take the servants of

- your lord and chase after him, that he may not actually find for himself fortified cities and escape before our eyes. (2 Samuel 20:6)**
- **And you will provide me escape from the faultfinding of my people. You will safeguard me to be the head of nations, a people that I have not known, they will serve me. (2 Samuel 22:44)**
 - **Eventually Adonijah held a sacrifice of sheep and cattle and fatlings close by the stone of Zoheleth, which is beside En-rogel, and he proceeded to invite all his brothers the king's sons and all the men of Judah the king's servants. (1 Kings 1:9)**
 - **For he has today gone down that he might sacrifice bulls and fatlings and sheep in great quantity and might invite all the sons of the king and the chiefs of the army and Abiathar the priest, and there they are eating and drinking before him and they keep saying; Let King Adonijah live! (1 Kings 1:25)**
 - **And Ahithophel was a counselor of the king, and Hushai the Archite was the king's companion. (1 Chronicles 27:33)**
 - **Why should I be afraid in the days of evil, when the very error of my supplanters surrounds me? (Psalms 49:5)**
 - **O God, the presumptuous ones themselves have risen up against me, and the very assembly of tyrannical ones have looked for my soul, and they have not set you in front of themselves. (Psalms 86:14)**
 - **And with words of hatred they have surrounded me, and they keep fighting against me without cause. (Psalms 109:3)**
