

2 Samuel 16:1 When David himself had crossed over a little beyond the summit, there was Ziba the attendant of Mephibosheth to meet him with a couple of asses saddled and upon them two hundred loaves of bread and a hundred cakes of raisins and a hundred loads of summer fruit and a large jar of wine.

[16] - References:

- And David was going up by the ascent of the Olives, weeping as he went up, with his head covered, and he was walking barefoot, and all the people that were with him covered each one his head, and they went up weeping as they went up. (2 Samuel 15:30)
- Now the house of Saul had a servant whose name was Ziba. So they called him to David, and the king then said to him; Are you Ziba? To which he said; I am your servant. (2 Samuel 9:2)
- The king now called Ziba, Saul's attendant, and said to him; Everything that had come to belong to Saul and to all his house I do give to the grandson of your master. (2 Samuel 9:9)
- When Mephibosheth the son of Jonathan the son of Saul came in to David, he at once fell upon his face and prostrated himself. Then David said; Mephibosheth! To which he said; Here is your servant. (2 Samuel 9:6)
- At once Abigail hastened and took two hundred loaves of bread and two large jars of wine and five sheep dressed and five seah measures of roasted grain and a hundred cakes of raisins and two hundred cakes of pressed figs and put them upon the asses. (1 Samuel 25:18)
- Then Jesse said to David his son; Take, please, to your brothers this ephah of roasted grain and these ten loaves of bread, and carry them quickly to the camp to your brothers. (1 Samuel 17:17)
- Brought beds and basins and potter's vessels, and wheat and barley and flour and roasted grain and broad beans and lentils and parched grain. (2 Samuel 17:28)
- Further, they gave him a slice of a cake of pressed figs and two cakes of raisins. Then he ate and his spirit returned to him, for he had not eaten bread or drunk water for three days and three nights. (1 Samuel 30:12)

- **And as for me, here I am dwelling in Mizpah, in order to stand before the Chaldeans who will come to us. And as for YOU yourselves, gather wine and summer fruits and oil and put them in YOUR vessels and dwell in YOUR cities that YOU have seized. (Jeremiah 40:10)**
- **This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah caused me to see, and, look! There was a basket of summer fruit. (Amos 8:1)**
- **Too bad for me, for I have become like the gatherings of summer fruit, like the gleaning of a grape gathering! There is no grape cluster to eat, no early fig, that my soul would desire! (Micah 7:1)**
- **And you must pass on from there still farther and come as far as the big tree of Tabor, and there there must encounter you three men going up to the true God at Bethel, one carrying three kids and one carrying three round loaves of bread and one carrying a large jar of wine. (1 Samuel 10:3)**
- **And there were with him a thousand men from Benjamin. And also Ziba the attendant of the house of Saul and his fifteen sons and twenty servants of his were with him, and they made it successfully to the Jordan before the king. (2 Samuel 19:17)**
- **In those days I saw in Judah people treading winepresses on the Sabbath and bringing in grain heaps and loading them upon asses, and also wine, grapes and figs and every sort of burden, and bringing them into Jerusalem on the Sabbath day, and I proceeded to bear witness against them on the day of their selling provisions. (Nehemiah 13:15)**
- **The gift is a stone winning favor in the eyes of its grand owner. Everywhere that he turns he has success. (Proverbs 17:8)**
- **And you must say to them this word; This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; Every large jar is something that gets filled with wine. And they will certainly say to you; Do we not positively know that every large jar is something that gets filled with wine? (Jeremiah 13:12)**
