

**2 Samuel 17:29** And honey and butter and sheep and curds of cattle they brought forward for David and the people that were with him to eat, for they said; The people are hungry and tired and thirsty in the wilderness.

[13] - References:

- And Jacob gave Esau bread and lentil stew, and he went to eating and drinking. Then he got up and went his way. So Esau despised the birthright. (**Genesis 25:34**)
- And next to him was Shammah the son of Agee the Hararite. And the Philistines proceeded to gather themselves to Lehi, where there then happened to be a tract of the field full of lentils, and the **people** themselves fled because of the Philistines. (**2 Samuel 23:11**)
- And I am proceeding to go down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land to a land good and spacious, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the locality of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. (**Exodus 3:8**)
- For the churning of milk is what brings forth **butter**, and the squeezing of the nose is what brings forth blood, and the squeezing out of anger is what brings forth quarreling. (**Proverbs 30:33**)
- The generous soul will itself be made fat, and the one freely watering others will himself also be freely watered. (**Proverbs 11:25**)
- And the foreign-speaking **people** showed us extraordinary human kindness, for they kindled a fire and received all of us helpfully because of the rain that was falling and because of the cold. (**Acts of Apostles 28:2**)
- Then the king **said** to Ziba; What do these things mean on your part? To this Ziba **said**; **The** asses are for the household of the king to ride, and the bread and the load of summer fruit are for the young men to **eat**, and the wine is for the one **tired** out in the wilderness to drink. (**2 Samuel 16:2**)

- He then took **butter** and milk and the young bull that he had got ready and set it before them. Then he himself kept standing by them under the tree as they were eating. (**Genesis 18:8**)
- And the men of Israel themselves were hard pressed on that day, and yet Saul put the **people** under the pledge of an oath, saying; Cursed is the man that **eats** bread before the evening and until I have taken vengeance upon my enemies! And none of the **people** tasted bread. (**1 Samuel 14:24**)
- At this one of the **people** answered and **said**; Your father solemnly put the **people** under oath, saying; Cursed is the man that **eats** bread today! And the **people** began to get **tired**. (**1 Samuel 14:28**)
- At once Abigail hastened and took two hundred loaves of bread and two large jars of wine and five **sheep** dressed and five seah measures of roasted grain and a hundred cakes of raisins and two hundred cakes of pressed figs and put them upon the asses. (**1 Samuel 25:18**)
- And also those near to them, as far as Issachar and Zebulun and Naphtali, were bringing food upon asses and upon camels and upon mules and upon **cattle**, eatables of flour, cakes of pressed figs and cakes of raisins and wine and oil and **cattle** and **sheep** in great quantity, for there was rejoicing in Israel. (**1 Chronicles 12:40**)
- And it must occur that, due to the abundance of the producing of milk, he will **eat butter**, because **butter** and honey are what everyone left remaining in the midst of the land will **eat**. (**Isaiah 7:22**)
