

2 Samuel 18:2 Further, David sent one third of the people under the hand of Joab and one third under the hand of Abishai the son of Zeruiah, Joab's brother, and one third under the hand of Ittai the Gittite. Then the king said to the people; I myself also shall without fail go out with YOU.

- Then he divided the three hundred men up into three bands and put horns in the hands of all of them and large empty jars, and torches inside the large jars. (**Judges 7:16**)
- By counsel plans themselves are firmly established, and by skillful direction carry on your war. (**Proverbs 20:18**)
- And Joab the son of Zeruiah was over the army, and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud was recorder. (**2 Samuel 8:16**)
- When David heard of it, then he sent Joab and all the army and the mighty men. (**2 Samuel 10:7**)
- As for Abishai the brother of Joab the son of Zeruiah, he was the head of the thirty, and he was brandishing his spear over three hundred slain ones, and he had a reputation like the three. (**2 Samuel 23:18**)
- And their sisters were Zeruiah and Abigail, and the sons of Zeruiah were Abishai and Joab and Asahel, three. (**1 Chronicles 2:16**)
- Then the king said to Ittai the Gittite; Why should you yourself also go with us? Go back and dwell with the king, for you are a foreigner and, besides, you are an exile from your place. (**2 Samuel 15:19**)
- But Ittai answered the king and said; As Yehowah is living and as my lord the king is living, in the place where my lord the king may come to be, whether for death or for life, there is where your servant will come to be! (**2 Samuel 15:21**)
- Now the three sons of Zeruiah happened to be there, Joab and Abishai and Asahel, and Asahel was swift on his feet, like one of the gazelles that are in the open field. (**2 Samuel 2:18**)

- At that David **said** to **Ittai**; Go and cross over. So **Ittai** the **Gittite** crossed over, and also all his men and all the little ones that were with him. (**2 Samuel 15:22**)
- Then a certain man saw it and told **Joab** and **said**; Look! I have seen Absalom hung in a big tree. (**2 Samuel 18:10**)
- As for **Abishai** the **brother** of **Joab**, he himself became head of the three, and he was brandishing his spear over three hundred slain, and he had a reputation like the three. (**1 Chronicles 11:20**)
