

2 Samuel 19:5 Finally Joab came in to the king at the house and said; You have today put to shame the face of all your servants, the ones providing escape for your soul today and for the soul of your sons and your daughters and the soul of your wives and the soul of your concubines.

[6] - References:

- He is **providing escape** for me from my angry enemies, above those who rise up against me you will lift me up, from the man of violence you will deliver me. (**Psalms 18:48**)
- And his second was Chileab by Abigail the wife of Nabal the Carmelite, and the third was Absalom the son of Maacah the daughter of Talmai the **king** of Geshur. (**2 Samuel 3:3**)
- And these are the names of those born to him in Jerusalem, Shammua and Shobab and Nathan and Solomon. (**2 Samuel 5:14**)
- And it **came** about after such things that Absalom the son of David had a beautiful sister whose name was Tamar, and Amnon the son of David fell in love with her. (**2 Samuel 13:1**)
- Meantime, David went on taking more **concubines** and **wives** out of Jerusalem after he **came** from Hebron, and more **sons** and **daughters** continued to be born to David. (**2 Samuel 5:13**)
- So the **king** went out with all his household at his feet, and the **king** left ten women, **concubines**, to take care of the **house**. (**2 Samuel 15:16**)
