

**2 Samuel 22:2** And he went on to say; Yehowah is my crag and my stronghold and the Provider of escape for me.

[6] - References:

- Yehowah is my **crag** and my **stronghold** and the **Provider** of **escape** for me. My God is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my horn of salvation, my secure height. (**Psalms 18:2**)
- For you are my **crag** and my **stronghold**, and for the sake of your name you will lead me and conduct me. (**Psalms 31:3**)
- My loving-kindness and my **stronghold**, my secure height and my **Provider** of **escape** for me, my shield and the One in whom I have taken refuge, the One subduing peoples under me. (**Psalms 144:2**)
- And on the fourth day they congregated together at the low plain of Beracah, for there they blessed Yehowah. That is why they called the name of that place Low Plain of Beracah, until today. (**2 Chronicles 20:26**)
- I will **say** to God my **crag**; Why have you forgotten me? Why do I walk sad because of the oppression of the enemy? (**Psalms 42:9**)
- Become to me a rock fortress into which to enter constantly. You must command to save me, for you are my **crag** and my **stronghold**. (**Psalms 71:3**)
