- So as to cause the outcry of the lowly one to come to him, and so he hears the outcry of the afflicted ones. (Job 34:28)
- And I shall certainly let remain in the midst of you a people humble and lowly, and they will actually take refuge in the name of Yehowah. (Zephaniah 3:12)
- Let flow the furious outbursts of your anger, and see every one haughty and bring him low. (Job 40:11)
- Because the afflicted people you yourself will save, but the haughty eyes you will abase. (Psalms 18:27)
- Anyone slandering his companion in secrecy, him I silence. Anyone of haughty eyes and of arrogant heart, him I cannot endure. (Psalms 101:5)
- Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, am praising and exalting and glorifying the King of the heavens, because all his works are truth and his ways are justice, and because those who are walking in pride he is able to humiliate. (Daniel 4:37)
- In like manner, you younger men, be in subjection to the older men. But all of you gird yourselves with lowliness of mind toward one another, because God opposes the haughty ones, but he gives undeserved kindness to the humble ones. (1 Peter 5:5)
- And if it acts haughtily, like a young lion you will hunt for me, and you will again show yourself marvelous in my case. (Job 10:16)
- See every one haughty, humble him, and tread down the wicked right where they are. (Job 40:12)
- O love Yehowah, all you loyal ones of his. The faithful ones Yehowah is safeguarding, but he is rewarding exceedingly anyone showing haughtiness. (Psalms 31:23)

- **Haughty eyes and an arrogant heart, the lamp of the wicked ones, are sin. (Proverbs 21:4)**
- **In that day you will not be ashamed because of all your dealings with which you transgressed against me, for then I shall remove from the midst of you your haughtily exultant ones, and you will never again be haughty in my holy mountain. (Zephaniah 3:11)**
