

2 Samuel 23:10 He it was that rose up and kept striking down the Philistines until his hand wearied and his hand kept cleaving to the sword, so that Yehowah performed a great salvation on that day, and as for the people, they returned behind him only to strip those struck down.

[8] - References:

- Eventually Gideon came to the Jordan, crossing it, he and the three hundred men that were with him, tired but keeping up the pursuit. (**Judges 8:4**)
- He, for his part, came as far as Lehi, and the **Philistines**, for their part, shouted exultantly at meeting him. And Yehowah's spirit became operative upon him, and the ropes that were upon his arms came to be like linen threads that have been scorched with fire, so that his fetters melted off his **hands**. (**Judges 15:14**)
- So Jonathan said to the attendant, his armor-bearer; Do come and let us cross over to the outpost of these uncircumcised men. Perhaps **Yehowah** will work for us, for there is no hindrance to **Yehowah** to save by many or by few. (**1 Samuel 14:6**)
- And he proceeded to put his soul in his palm and strike the Philistine **down**, so that **Yehowah performed a great salvation** for all Israel. You saw it, and you gave way to rejoicing. So why should you sin against innocent blood in having David put to death for nothing? (**1 Samuel 19:5**)
- But he took his stand in the middle of the tract and delivered it, and **kept striking down** the **Philistines**, so that **Yehowah** saved with a **great salvation**. (**1 Chronicles 11:14**)
- The One giving **salvation** to kings, the One setting David his servant free from the injurious **sword**. (**Psalms 144:10**)
- Even the kings of armies flee, they flee. As for her who abides at home, she shares in the spoil. (**Psalms 68:12**)
- And after him there was Eleazar the son of Dodo the Ahohite. He was among the three mighty men. (**1 Chronicles 11:12**)
