

2 Samuel 2:29 As for Abner and his men, they marched through the Arabah all that night and went crossing the Jordan and marching through the entire gully and finally came to Mahanaim.

[8] - References:

- Turn and set out on **YOUR** way and go into the mountainous region of the Amorites and to all their neighbors in the **Arabah**, the mountainous region and the Shephelah and the Negeb and the seacoast, the land of the Canaanites, and Lebanon, up to the great river, the river Euphrates. (**Deuteronomy 1:7**)
- And the **Arabah** as far as the sea of Chinnereth toward the east and as far as the sea of the **Arabah**, the Salt Sea, to the east in the direction of Beth-jeshimoth, and toward the south under the slopes of Pisgah. (**Joshua 12:3**)
- I am unworthy of all the loving kindnesses and of all the faithfulness that you have exercised toward your servant, for with but my staff I crossed this **Jordan** and now I have become two camps. (**Genesis 32:10**)
- And it **came** about that as soon as the whole nation had completed passing over the **Jordan**, Yehowah proceeded to say to Joshua. (**Joshua 4:1**)
- Immediately Jacob said, when he saw them; The camp of God this is! Hence he called the name of that place **Mahanaim**. (**Genesis 32:2**)
- And out of the tribe of Gad, the city of refuge for the manslayer, namely, Ramoth in Gilead, and its pasture ground, and **Mahanaim** and its pasture ground. (**Joshua 21:38**)
- As for Abner the son of Ner the chief of the army that had belonged to Saul, he took Ish-bosheth, Saul's son, and proceeded to bring him across to **Mahanaim**. (**2 Samuel 2:8**)
- As for David, he **came** to **Mahanaim**, and Absalom himself crossed the **Jordan**, he and all the **men** of Israel with him. (**2 Samuel 17:24**)
