

2 Samuel 7:18 At that King David came in and sat down before Yehowah and said; Who am I, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah? And what is my house that you have brought me thus far?

[8] - References:

- I **am** unworthy of all the loving kindnesses and of all the faithfulness that you **have** exercised toward your servant, for with but my staff I crossed this Jordan and now I **have** become two camps. (**Genesis 32:10**)
- A Raiser of a lowly one from the dust, from the ashpit he lifts up a poor one, to make them sit with nobles, and a throne of glory he gives to them as a possession. For to **Yehowah** belong earth's supports, and he places upon them the productive land. (**1 Samuel 2:8**)
- At this **David said** to Saul; **Who am I** and who are my kinsfolk, my father's family, in Israel, so that I should become son-in-law to the king? (**1 Samuel 18:18**)
- After that King **David came** in and **sat down before Yehowah** and **said**; **Who am I**, O **Yehowah** God, and **what** is my **house** that you **have brought** me thus **far**? (**1 Chronicles 17:16**)
- He has told you, O earthling man, **what** is good. And **what** is **Yehowah** asking back from you but to exercise justice and to love kindness and to be modest in walking with your God? (**Micah 6:8**)
- However, Moses **said** to the true God; **Who am I** that I should go to Pharaoh and that I **have** to bring the sons of Israel out of Egypt? (**Exodus 3:11**)
- And yet, who **am** I and who are my people, that we should retain power to make voluntary offerings like this? For everything is from you, and out of your own hand we **have** given to you. (**1 Chronicles 29:14**)
- And who could retain power to build him a **house**? For the heavens and the heaven of the heavens cannot contain him, and who **am** I that I should build him a **house** except for making sacrificial smoke **before** him? (**2 Chronicles 2:6**)
