[10] - References:

- The scepter will not turn aside from Judah, neither the commander's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh comes, and to him the obedience of the peoples will belong. (**Genesis 49:10**)
- I shall see him, but not now, I shall behold him, but not near. A star will certainly step forth out of Jacob, and a scepter will indeed rise out of Israel. And he will certainly break apart the temples of Moab's head and the cranium of all the sons of tumult of war. (**Numbers 24:17**)
- It is not for your righteousness or for the uprightness of your heart that you are going in to take possession of their land, in fact, it is for the wickedness of these nations that Yehowah your God is driving them away from before you, and in order to carry out the word that Yehowah swore to your forefathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. (**Deuteronomy 9:5**)
- Now, look! I am going today in the way of all the earth, and YOU well know with all YOUR hearts and with all YOUR souls that not one word out of all the good words that Yehowah YOUR God has spoken to YOU has failed. They have all come true for YOU. Not one word of them has failed. (**Joshua 23:14**)

- Just as he told to our forefathers, to Abraham and to his seed, forever. (**Luke 1:55**)
- O Yehowah, for the sake of your servant and in agreement with your own heart you have done all these great things by making all the great achievements known. (**1 Chronicles 17:19**)
- The intimacy with Yehowah belongs to those fearful of him, also his covenant, to cause them to know it. (**Psalms 25:14**)

- **For the Sovereign Lord Yehowah will not do a thing unless he has revealed his confidential matter to his **servants** the prophets. (Amos 3:7)**
- **And it came about at the time that the grain offering goes up that Elijah the prophet began to approach and say; O Yehowah, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Israel, today let it be known that you are God in Israel and I am your **servant** and it is by your **word** that I **have** done all these **things**.
