

1 Kings 10:10 Then she gave the king a hundred and twenty talents of gold and a very great deal of balsam oil and precious stones. There never came anymore the like of that balsam oil for quantity such as the queen of Sheba gave to King Solomon.

[10] - References:

- The **kings** of Tarshish and of the islands; Tribute they will pay. The **kings** of **Sheba** and of Seba, a gift they will present. (**Psalms 72:10**)
- Then she **gave** the **king** a **hundred** and **twenty talents** of **gold**, and **balsam oil** in very **great quantity**, and **precious stones**, and there had not come to be the like of that **balsam oil** which the **queen** of **Sheba** gave to **King Solomon**. (**2 Chronicles 9:9**)
- So Israel their father said to them; If, then, that is the case, do this; Take the finest products of the land in **YOUR** receptacles and carry them down to the man as a gift, a little **balsam**, and a little honey, labdanum and resinous bark, pistachio nuts and almonds. (**Genesis 43:11**)
- As for the good-for-nothing men, they said; How will this one save us? Accordingly they despised him, and they did not bring any gift to him. But he continued like one grown speechless. (**1 Samuel 10:27**)
- In the meantime Hiram sent to the **king** a **hundred** and **twenty talents** of **gold**. (**1 Kings 9:14**)
- And Hezekiah proceeded to listen to them and show them all his treasure-house, the silver and the **gold** and the **balsam oil** and the good **oil** and his armory and all that was to be found in his treasures. There proved to be nothing that Hezekiah did not show them in his own house and in all his dominion. (**2 Kings 20:13**)
- And Hezekiah **came** to have riches and glory to a very **great** amount, and storehouses he made for himself for silver and for **gold** and for **precious stones** and for **balsam oil** and for shields and for all the desirable articles. (**2 Chronicles 32:27**)
- Because of your temple at Jerusalem, **kings** will bring gifts to you yourself. (**Psalms 68:29**)

- **And let him live, and to him let some of the gold of Sheba be given. And in his behalf let prayer be made constantly, all day long let him be blessed. (Psalms 72:15)**
- **I accumulated also silver and gold for myself, and property peculiar to kings and the jurisdictional districts. I made male singers and female singers for myself and the exquisite delights of the sons of mankind, a lady, even ladies. (Ecclesiastes 2:8)**
