[4] - References:

- As Samuel was turning about to go, he immediately grabbed hold of the skirt of his sleeveless coat, but it ripped away. (1 Samuel 15:27)
- All these are the twelve tribes of Israel, and this is what their father spoke to them when he was blessing them. He blessed them each one according to his own blessing. (Genesis 49:28)
- Accordingly Moses wrote down all the words of Yehowah. Then he got up early in the morning and built at the foot of the mountain an altar and twelve pillars corresponding with the twelve tribes of Israel. (Exodus 24:4)
- And the king did not listen to the people, for it proved to be a turn of affairs from the true God in order that Yehowah might carry out his word that he had spoken by means of Ahijah the Shilonite to Jeroboam the son of Nebat. (2 Chronicles 10:15)
