

1 Kings 12:27· If this people continues going up to render sacrifices in the house of Yehowah in Jerusalem, the heart of this people will also be bound to return to their lord,¹ Rehoboam the king of Judah, and they will certainly kill me and return to Rehoboam the king of Judah.

Footnote: Their lord Hebrew, 'adho·neh·hem', plural of 'a·dhohn', to denote excellence

- But to the place that **Yehowah** **YOUR** God **will** choose out of all **YOUR** tribes to place his name there, to have it reside, **YOU will** seek, and there you must come. (**Deuteronomy 12:5**)
- That your eyes may prove to be opened toward this **house** night and day, toward the place of which you said; My name **will** prove to be there, to listen to the prayer with which your servant prays toward this place. (**1 Kings 8:29**)
- And the one tribe is what **will** continue his for the sake of my servant David and for the sake of **Jerusalem**, the city that I have chosen out of all the tribes of Israel. (**1 Kings 11:32**)
