

**1 Kings 13:24** And he got on his way. Later a lion found him on the road and put him to death, and his dead body came to be thrown onto the road. And the ass was standing beside it, and the lion was standing beside the dead body.

- Therefore he said to him; For the reason that you did not listen to the voice of Yehowah, here you are going away from me, and a **lion** will certainly strike you down. After that he went away from beside him, and the **lion** got to find him and strike him down. (**1 Kings 20:36**)
- And it **came** about at the start of their dwelling there that they did not fear Yehowah. Therefore Yehowah sent **lions** among them, and they **came** to be killers among them. (**2 Kings 17:25**)
- Just as when a man flees because of the **lion**, and the bear actually meets him, and as when he went into the house and supported his hand against the wall, and the serpent bit him. (**Amos 5:19**)
- At that Yehowah's anger blazed against Uzzah and the true God struck him down there for the irreverent act, so that he died there close by the ark of the true God. (**2 Samuel 6:7**)
- Yehowah is a God exacting exclusive devotion and taking vengeance, Yehowah is taking vengeance and is disposed to rage. Yehowah is taking vengeance against his adversaries, and he is resentful toward his enemies. (**Nahum 1:2**)
