

1 Kings 13:34 And in this thing there came to be a cause of sin on the part of the household of Jeroboam and an occasion for effacing them and annihilating them off the surface of the ground.

- And this thing came to be a cause for sin, and the people began to go before the one as far as Dan. (**1 Kings 12:30**)
- And it came about that, as if it were the most trivial thing for him to walk in the sins of **Jeroboam** the son of Nebat, he now took as wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal the king of the Sidonians and began to go and serve Baal and to bow down to him. (**1 Kings 16:31**)
- Only he stuck to the sins of **Jeroboam** the son of Nebat, with which he caused Israel to sin. He did not depart from them. (**2 Kings 3:3**)
- And Jehu himself did not take care to walk in the Law of Yehowah the God of Israel with all his heart. He did not turn aside from the sins of **Jeroboam** with which he caused Israel to sin. (**2 Kings 10:31**)
- And he continued to do what was bad in Yehowah's eyes and went walking in pursuit of the sin of **Jeroboam** the son of Nebat, with which he caused Israel to sin. He did not turn aside from it. (**2 Kings 13:2**)
- For he ripped Israel off from the house of David, and they proceeded to make **Jeroboam** the son of Nebat king, and **Jeroboam** proceeded to **part** Israel from following Yehowah, and he caused them to sin with a great sin. (**2 Kings 17:21**)
- For that reason here I am bringing calamity upon the house of **Jeroboam**, and I shall certainly cut off from **Jeroboam** anyone urinating against a wall, a helpless and worthless one in Israel, and I shall indeed make a clean sweep behind the house of **Jeroboam**, just as one clears away the dung until it is disposed of. (**1 Kings 14:10**)
- And it came about that as soon as he became king, he struck down all the house of **Jeroboam**. He did not let anyone breathing remain of Jeroboam's until he had annihilated them, according to

- Yehowah's word that he had spoken by means of his servant Ahijah the Shilonite. (1 Kings 15:29)**
- **Until Yehowah removed Israel from his sight, just as he had spoken by means of all his servants the prophets. So Israel went off its own soil into exile in Assyria down to this day. (2 Kings 17:23)**
 - **For Yehowah your God in your midst is a God exacting exclusive devotion, for fear the anger of Yehowah your God may blaze against you and he must annihilate you from off the surface of the ground. (Deuteronomy 6:15)**
 - **And he will give Israel up on account of the sins of Jeroboam with which he sinned and with which he caused Israel to sin. (1 Kings 14:16)**
 - **And he continued to do what was bad in Yehowah's eyes. He did not depart from all the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, with which he caused Israel to sin. (2 Kings 14:24)**
 - **Their fruitage you will destroy from the very earth, and their offspring from the sons of men. (Psalms 21:10)**
 - **They themselves have set up kings, but not because of me. They have set up princes, but I did not know it. With their silver and their gold they have made for themselves idols, to the end that they may be cut off. (Hosea 8:4)**
 - **Look! The eyes of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah are upon the sinful kingdom, and he will certainly annihilate it from upon the surface of the ground. Nevertheless, I shall not completely annihilate the house of Jacob, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Amos 9:8)**
