

**1 Kings 14:15** And Yehowah will indeed strike Israel down, just as the reed sways in the water, and he will certainly uproot Israel off this good ground that he gave to their forefathers, and he will indeed scatter them beyond the River,<sup>1</sup> for the reason that they made their sacred poles, so offending Yehowah.

- But if **YOU** flagrantly do what is bad, **YOU will** be swept away, both **YOU** and **YOUR** king. (**1 Samuel 12:25**)
- And it must occur that should they say to you; Where shall we go out to? You must also say to them; This is what **Yehowah** has said; Whoever is for deadly plague, to deadly plague! And whoever is for the sword, to the sword! And whoever is for the famine, to the famine! And whoever is for the captivity, to the captivity! (**Jeremiah 15:2**)
- Hence **Yehowah** uprooted them from off their soil in anger and rage and great indignation and threw them into another land as at this day. (**Deuteronomy 29:28**)
- In the ninth year of Hoshea, the king of Assyria captured Samaria and then led **Israel** into exile in Assyria and kept them dwelling in Halah and in Habor at the river Gozan and in the cities of the Medes. (**2 Kings 17:6**)
- In reply he said; Every plant that my heavenly Father did not plant **will** be uprooted. (**Matthew 15:13**)
- For **Yehowah** your God is bringing you into a **good** land, a land of torrent valleys of **water**, springs and watery deeps issuing forth in the valley plain and in the mountainous region. (**Deuteronomy 8:7**)
- And it must occur that, **just** as all the **good** word that **Yehowah YOUR** God has spoken to **YOU** has come upon **YOU**, so **Yehowah will** bring upon **YOU** all the evil word until he has annihilated **YOU** from off this **good ground** that **Yehowah YOUR** God has given **YOU**. (**Joshua 23:15**)
- And **Yehowah will certainly scatter** you among all the peoples from the one end of the earth to the other end of the earth, and

- there you **will** have to serve other gods whom you have not known, neither you nor your **forefathers**, wood and stone. (**Deuteronomy 28:64**)
- In the days of Pekah the king of **Israel**, Tiglath-pileser the king of Assyria came in and proceeded to take Ijon and Abel-beth-maacah and Janoah and Kedesh and Hazor and Gilead and Galilee, all the land of Naphtali, and to carry them into exile in Assyria. (**2 Kings 15:29**)
  - After that the king of Assyria took **Israel** into exile in Assyria and set them **down** in Halah and in Habor at the river Gozan and in the cities of the Medes. (**2 Kings 18:11**)
  - And David went on to **strike down** Hadadezer the son of Rehob the king of Zobah as he was going his way to put his control back again at the river Euphrates. (**2 Samuel 8:3**)
  - And **you** must pull **down** their altars and shatter their **sacred** pillars, and **you** should burn their **sacred poles** in the fire and cut **down** the graven images of their gods, and **you** must destroy their names from that place. (**Deuteronomy 12:3**)
  - But you began to act worse than all those who happened to be prior to you, and you went and **made** for yourself another god and molten images to offend me, and it is I whom you have cast behind your back. (**1 Kings 14:9**)
  - Only they did not depart from the sin of the house of Jeroboam, with which he caused **Israel** to sin. In it he walked, and even the **sacred** pole itself stood in Samaria. (**2 Kings 13:6**)
  - And they kept leaving all the commandments of **Yehowah** their God and proceeded to make for themselves molten statues, two calves, and to make a **sacred** pole, and they began to bow **down** to all the army of the heavens and to serve Baal. (**2 Kings 17:16**)
  - Over the fact that they had not listened to the voice of **Yehowah** their God, but kept overstepping his covenant, even all that Moses the servant of **Yehowah** had commanded. They neither listened nor performed. (**2 Kings 18:12**)
