

1 Kings 14:21 As for Rehoboam the son of Solomon, he had become king in Judah. Forty-one years old Rehoboam was when he began to reign, and seventeen years he reigned in Jerusalem, the city that Yehowah had chosen out of all the tribes of Israel to put his name there. And his mother's name was Naamah the Ammonitess.

- Then **Solomon** lay down with his forefathers, and was buried in the City of David his father, and **Rehoboam** his son began to reign in place of him. (**1 Kings 11:43**)
- And it came about that, as soon as the kingship of **Rehoboam** was firmly established and as soon as he was strong, he left the Law of **Yehowah**, and also all **Israel** with him. (**2 Chronicles 12:1**)
- From the day that I brought my people **Israel** out from Egypt I have not **chosen** a **city** out of all the **tribes** of **Israel** to build a house for my **name** to continue there, but I shall choose David to come to be over my people **Israel**. (**1 Kings 8:16**)
- And to his **son** I shall give one tribe, in order that David my servant may continue having a lamp always before me in **Jerusalem**, the **city** that I have **chosen** for myself to **put** my **name** there. (**1 Kings 11:36**)
- And King **Rehoboam** continued to make his position strong in **Jerusalem** and kept reigning, for **Rehoboam** was forty-one years old when he **began** to **reign**, and for **seventeen years** he **reigned** in **Jerusalem**, the **city** that **Yehowah** had **chosen** out of all the **tribes** of **Israel** to **put** his **name** there. And his **mother's name** was **Naamah** the **Ammonitess**. (**2 Chronicles 12:13**)
- But he chose the tribe of **Judah**, mount Zion, which he loved. (**Psalms 78:68**)
- For **Yehowah** has **chosen** Zion, he has longed for it as a dwelling for himself. (**Psalms 132:13**)
- An altar of ground you are to make for me, and you must sacrifice upon it your burnt offerings and your communion sacrifices, your flock and your herd. In every place where I shall cause my **name** to be remembered I shall come to you and shall certainly bless you. (**Exodus 20:24**)

- But to the place that **Yehowah** **YOUR** God will choose **out** of all **YOUR tribes** to place his **name** there, to have it reside, **YOU** will seek, and there you must come. (**Deuteronomy 12:5**)
- And King **Solomon** himself loved many foreign wives along with the daughter of Pharaoh, Moabite, Ammonite, Edomite, Sidonian and Hittite women. (**1 Kings 11:1**)
- And King **Rehoboam** continued to make his position strong in **Jerusalem** and kept reigning, for **Rehoboam** was forty-one **years old** when he **began to reign**, and for **seventeen years** he **reigned in Jerusalem**, the **city** that **Yehowah** had **chosen out** of all the **tribes of Israel** to **put his name** there. And his **mother's name** was **Naamah** the **Ammonitess**. (**2 Chronicles 12:13**)
- Finally **Solomon** lay down with his forefathers. So they buried him in the City of David his father, and **Rehoboam** his **son began to reign** in place of him. (**2 Chronicles 9:31**)
- And it came about in the fifth year of King **Rehoboam** that **Shishak** the **king** of Egypt came up against **Jerusalem**, for they had behaved unfaithfully toward **Yehowah**. (**2 Chronicles 12:2**)
