

1 Kings 14:22 And Judah went on doing what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah, so that they incited him to jealousy more than all that their forefathers had done by their sins with which they sinned.

- So the sons of Israel did **what** was **bad** in Yehowah's **eyes**, and they were forgetful of **Yehowah** their God and **went** serving the Baals and the sacred poles. (**Judges 3:7**)
- Even Judah itself did not keep the commandments of **Yehowah** their God, but they **went** walking in the statutes of Israel that they had made. (**2 Kings 17:19**)
- And it came about that, as soon as the kingship of Rehoboam was firmly established and as soon as he was strong, he left the Law of **Yehowah**, and also all Israel with him. (**2 Chronicles 12:1**)
- When I got to see that, for the very reason that unfaithful Israel had committed adultery, I sent her away and proceeded to give the certificate of her full divorce to her, yet treacherously dealing Judah her sister did not become afraid, but she herself also began to go and commit prostitution. (**Jeremiah 3:8**)
- For you must not prostrate yourself to another god, because **Yehowah**, whose name is Jealous, he is a jealous God. (**Exodus 34:14**)
- For **Yehowah** your God is a consuming fire, a God exacting exclusive devotion. (**Deuteronomy 4:24**)
- And they kept offending him with their high places, and with their graven images they kept inciting him to **jealousy**. (**Psalms 78:58**)
- I have spread out my hands all day long to a stubborn people, those who are walking in the way that is not good, after their thoughts. (**Isaiah 65:2**)
- Or are we inciting **Yehowah** to jealousy? We are not stronger than he is, are we? (**1 Corinthians 10:22**)
- So the sons of Israel did **what** was **bad** in Yehowah's **eyes**, and they were forgetful of **Yehowah** their God and **went** serving the Baals and the sacred poles. (**Judges 3:7**)

- **It was then that Solomon proceeded to build a high place to Chemosh the disgusting thing of Moab on the mountain that was in front of Jerusalem, and to Molech the disgusting thing of the sons of Ammon. (1 Kings 11:7)**
- **They began inciting him to jealousy with strange gods; With detestable things they kept offending him. (Deuteronomy 32:16)**
- **As for the sacrificial smoke that YOU made in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, YOU and YOUR forefathers, YOUR kings and YOUR princes and the people of the land, was it not this that Yehowah remembered and that proceeded to come up into his heart? (Jeremiah 44:21)**
