

**1 Kings 14:23** And they too kept building for themselves high places and sacred pillars and sacred poles upon every high hill and under every luxuriant tree.

[26] - References:

- And **you** must pull down their altars and shatter their **sacred pillars**, and **you** should burn their **sacred poles** in the fire and cut down the graven images of their gods, and **you** must destroy their names from that place. (**Deuteronomy 12:3**)
- **You** must not make valueless gods for yourselves, and **you** must not set up a carved image or a **sacred pillar** for yourselves, and **you** must not put a stone as a showpiece in **YOUR** land in order to bow down toward it, for I am Yehowah **YOUR** God. (**Leviticus 26:1**)
- And he kept on doing what was bad in Yehowah's eyes, only not like his father or like his mother, but he removed the **sacred pillar** of Baal that his father had made. (**2 Kings 3:2**)
- So he built again the **high places** that Hezekiah his father had destroyed, and set up altars to Baal and made a **sacred pole**, just as Ahab the king of Israel had done, and he began to bow down to all the army of the heavens and to serve them. (**2 Kings 21:3**)
- For their own errors and for the errors of their forefathers at the same time; Yehowah has said. Because they have made sacrificial smoke upon the mountains, and upon the **hills** they have reproached me, I will also measure out their wages first of all into their own bosom. (**Isaiah 65:7**)
- For long ago I broke your yoke to pieces, I tore your bands apart. But you said; I am not going to serve, for upon every **high hill** and **under** every **luxuriant tree** you were lying sprawled out, prostituting yourself. (**Jeremiah 2:20**)
- On the tops of the mountains they sacrifice, and on the **hills** they make sacrificial smoke, **under** massive **tree** and storax **tree** and big **tree**, because its shade is good. That is why **YOUR** daughters commit fornication and **YOUR** own daughters-in-law commit adultery. (**Hosea 4:13**)
- **You** should absolutely destroy all the **places** where the nations whom **you** are dispossessing have served their gods, on the tall

mountains and the **hills** and **under** every **luxuriant tree**.  
(**Deuteronomy 12:2**)

- And he regularly sacrificed and made sacrificial smoke on the **high places** and upon the **hills** and **under** every sort of **luxuriant tree**. (**2 Chronicles 28:4**)
- Those who are working up passion among big **trees**, **under** every **luxuriant tree**, slaughtering the children in the torrent valleys **under** the clefts of the crags? (**Isaiah 57:5**)
- Accordingly he had the male temple prostitutes pass out of the land and removed all the dungy idols that his forefathers had made. (**1 Kings 15:12**)
- And he kept walking in all the way of Asa his father. He did not turn aside from it, by doing what was right in the eyes of Yehowah. Only the **high places** themselves did not disappear. The people were still sacrificing and making sacrificial smoke on the **high places**. (**1 Kings 22:43**)
- Then they brought out the **sacred pillars** of the house of Baal and burned each one. (**2 Kings 10:26**)
- And he kept sacrificing and making sacrificial smoke on the **high places** and upon the **hills** and **under** every **luxuriant tree**. (**2 Kings 16:4**)
- So he removed the foreign altars and the **high places** and broke up the **sacred pillars** and cut down the **sacred poles**. (**2 Chronicles 14:3**)
- And the **high places** themselves did not disappear from Israel. Only Asa's heart itself proved to be complete all his days. (**2 Chronicles 15:17**)
- And gradually they left the house of Yehowah the God of their forefathers and began serving the **sacred poles** and the idols, so that there came to be indignation against Judah and Jerusalem because of this guilt of theirs. (**2 Chronicles 24:18**)
- And in all cities, even the cities of Judah, he made **high places** for making sacrificial smoke to other gods, so that he offended Yehowah the God of his forefathers. (**2 Chronicles 28:25**)

- So he built again the **high places** that Hezekiah his father had pulled down, and set up altars to the Baals and made **sacred poles**, and he began to bow down to all the army of the heavens and serve them. (**2 Chronicles 33:3**)
- And they kept offending him with their **high places**, and with their graven images they kept inciting him to jealousy. (**Psalms 78:58**)
- And Yehowah proceeded to say to me in the days of Josiah the king; Have you seen what unfaithful Israel has done? She is going upon every **high** mountain and underneath every **luxuriant tree**, that she may commit prostitution there. (**Jeremiah 3:6**)
- When their sons remember their altars and their **sacred poles** beside a **luxuriant tree**, upon the **high hills**. (**Jeremiah 17:2**)
- And **you** people will have to know that I am Yehowah, when their slain ones come to be in the midst of their dungy idols, all around their altars, upon every **high hill**, on all the tops of the mountains and **under** every **luxuriant tree** and **under** every branchy big **tree**, the place where they have offered a restful odor to all their dungy idols. (**Ezekiel 6:13**)
- And you proceeded to take some of your garments and make for yourself **high places** of varied colors and you would prostitute yourself on them, such things are not coming in, and it should not happen. (**Ezekiel 16:16**)
- And I proceeded to bring them into the land that I had lifted up my hand in an oath to give them. When they got to see every exalted **hill** and every branchy **tree**, then they began sacrificing there their sacrifices and giving there their offensive offering, and presenting there their restful odors and pouring out there their drink offerings. (**Ezekiel 20:28**)
- Israel is a degenerating vine. Fruit he keeps putting forth for himself. In proportion to the abundance of his fruit he has multiplied his altars. In proportion to the goodness of his land, they put up good **pillars**. (**Hosea 10:1**)
