

1 Kings 15:1 And in the eighteenth year of King Jeroboam the son of Nebat, Abijah became king over Judah.

[5] - References:

- And it came about that as soon as all Israel heard that **Jeroboam** had returned, they at once sent and called him to the assembly and made him **king** over all Israel. None **became** a follower of the house of David except the tribe of **Judah** by itself. (**1 Kings 12:20**)
- And it came about that as soon as **Jeroboam** the **son** of **Nebat** heard of it while he was yet in Egypt, because he had run off on account of **King** Solomon, that **Jeroboam** might dwell in Egypt. (**1 Kings 12:2**)
- Consequently Rehoboam put Abijah the **son** of Maacah in office as head, as leader among his brothers, for he thought of making him **king**. (**2 Chronicles 11:22**)
- In the eighteenth **year** of **King Jeroboam** it was that Abijah began to reign over **Judah**. (**2 Chronicles 13:1**)
- And after her he took Maacah the granddaughter of Absalom. In time she bore him Abijah and Attai and Ziza and Shelomith. (**2 Chronicles 11:20**)
