

1 Kings 15:14 And the high places he did not remove. Nevertheless, Asa's heart itself proved to be complete with Yehowah all his days.

- And **you** must drive away all the inhabitants of the land from before **you** and destroy all their stone figures, and all their images of molten metal **you** should destroy, and all their sacred high **places** **you** should annihilate. (**Numbers 33:52**)
- **You** should absolutely destroy all the **places** where the nations whom **you** are dispossessing have served their gods, on the tall mountains and the hills and under every luxuriant tree. (**Deuteronomy 12:2**)
- And he kept walking in all the way of Asa his father. He did not turn aside from it, by doing what was right in the eyes of **Yehowah**. Only the high **places** themselves did not disappear. The people were still sacrificing and making sacrificial smoke on the high **places**. (**1 Kings 22:43**)
- Then they answered them and said; He is. Look! He is ahead of you. Hurry now, because today he has come to the city, for there is a sacrifice today for the people on the high place. (**1 Samuel 9:12**)
- And **your heart** must prove to be **complete** with **Yehowah** our God by walking in his regulations and by keeping his commandments as at this day. (**1 Kings 8:61**)
- And the high **places** themselves did not disappear from Israel. Only **Asa's heart** itself **proved** to be **complete** all his **days**. (**2 Chronicles 15:17**)
- Only the people were sacrificing on the high **places**, for a house had not been built to the name of **Yehowah** down to those **days**. (**1 Kings 3:2**)
- And Solomon continued to love **Yehowah** by walking in the statutes of David his father. Only it was on the high **places** that he was regularly sacrificing and making offerings smoke. (**1 Kings 3:3**)

- **It was only the high **places** that did not disappear. The people were still sacrificing and making sacrificial smoke on the high **places**. (2 Kings 14:4)**
- **Only the high **places** themselves did not disappear, and the people themselves had not yet prepared their **heart** for the God of their forefathers. (2 Chronicles 20:33)**
