

1 Kings 15:22· And King Asa, for his part, summoned all Judah, there was none exempt, and they proceeded to carry the stones of Ramah and the timbers of it, with which Baasha had been building, and King Asa began to build with them Geba in Benjamin, and Mizpah.

- As for **Asa** the king, he took all **Judah**, and they **proceeded to carry away the stones of Ramah** and its **timbers** with which **Baasha** had built, and he **began to build** with them **Geba** and **Mizpah**. (**2 Chronicles 16:6**)
- And Chephar-ammoni and Ophni and **Geba**, twelve cities and their settlements. (**Joshua 18:24**)
- And out of the tribe of **Benjamin**, Gibeon and its pasture ground, **Geba** and its pasture ground. (**Joshua 21:17**)
- And Mizpeh and Chephirah and Mozah. (**Joshua 18:26**)
- Consequently all the sons of Israel went out and the assembly congregated themselves as one man, from Dan down to Beer-sheba along with the land of Gilead, to Yehowah at **Mizpah**. (**Judges 20:1**)
- Then Samuel said; Collect all Israel together at **Mizpah**, that I may pray in **YOUR** behalf to Yehowah. (**1 Samuel 7:5**)
- Accordingly Jeremiah came to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam at **Mizpah** and took up dwelling with him in the midst of the people who were left remaining in the land. (**Jeremiah 40:6**)
- Now the men of Israel had sworn in **Mizpah**, saying; Not a man of us will give his daughter to **Benjamin** as a wife. (**Judges 21:1**)
- Then he brought all the priests from the cities of **Judah**, that he might make unfit for worship the high places where the priests had made sacrificial smoke, from **Geba** as far as Beer-sheba, and he pulled down the high places of the gates that were at the entrance of the gate of Joshua, the chief of the city, which was at the left as a person came into the gate of the city. (**2 Kings 23:8**)
- And the Fountain Gate was what Shallun the son of Colhozeh, a prince of the district of **Mizpah**, repaired, he himself **proceeded to**

- build** it and to roof it over and to set up its doors, its bolts and its bars, and also the wall of the Pool of the Canal to the King's Garden and as far as the Stairway that goes down from the City of David. (**Nehemiah 3:15**)
- And all the Jews **began** to return from all the places to which they had been dispersed, and they kept coming into the land of **Judah** to Gedaliah at **Mizpah**. And they went gathering wine and summer fruits in very great quantity. (**Jeremiah 40:12**)
 - Now the cistern into which Ishmael threw all the carcasses of the men that he had struck down was a great cistern, the one that **King Asa** had made because of **Baasha** the king of Israel. It was the one that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah filled with those slain. (**Jeremiah 41:9**)
 - The whole land will be changed like the Arabah, from **Geba** to Rimmon to the south of Jerusalem, and she must rise and become inhabited in her place, from the Gate of **Benjamin** all the way to the place of the First Gate, all the way to the Corner Gate, and from the Tower of Hananel all the way to the press vats of the king. (**Zechariah 14:10**)
