

**1 Kings 16:7** And also by means of Jehu the son of Hanani the prophet, Yehowah's word itself had come against Baasha and his house, both because of all the badness that he committed in the eyes of Yehowah by offending him with the work of his hands, that it might become like the house of Jeroboam, and because he struck him<sup>1</sup> down.

- You must not bow **down** to them nor be induced to serve them, because I **Yehowah** your God am a God exacting exclusive devotion, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon **sons**, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation, in the case of those who hate me. (**Exodus 20:5**)
- Preserving loving-kindness for thousands, pardoning error and transgression and sin, but by no means will he give exemption from punishment, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon **sons** and upon grandsons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation. (**Exodus 34:7**)
- On account of all the sins of **Baasha** and the sins of Elah his **son** with which they sinned and with which they caused Israel to sin by **offending Yehowah** the God of Israel with their vain idols. (**1 Kings 16:13**)
- Their idols are silver and gold, the **work** of the **hands** of earthling man. (**Psalms 115:4**)
- And their land is filled with valueless gods. To the **work** of one's **hands** they bow **down**, to that which one's fingers have made. (**Isaiah 2:8**)
- The formers of the carved image are all of them an unreality, and their darlings themselves will be of no benefit, and as their witnesses they see nothing and know nothing, in order that they may be ashamed. (**Isaiah 44:9**)
- And **Yehowah** will certainly raise up to himself a king over Israel who will cut off the **house** of **Jeroboam** the said day, and what if right now? (**1 Kings 14:14**)

- **And Baasha the son of Ahijah of the house of Issachar began to conspire against him, and Baasha got to strike him down at Gibbethon, which belonged to the Philistines, while Nadab and all Israel were besieging Gibbethon. (1 Kings 15:27)**
  
- **And he kept doing what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah and went on walking in the way of his father and in his sin with which he caused Israel to sin. (1 Kings 15:26)**
  
- **And he kept doing what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah and went walking in the way of Jeroboam and in his sin with which he caused Israel to sin. (1 Kings 15:34)**
