- **Yehowah** your **God** you should fear, and him you should serve, and by his name you should swear. (**Deuteronomy 6:13**)
- And if you will certainly swear; As **Yehowah** is alive in truth, in justice and in righteousness! then in him the nations will actually bless themselves, and in him they will boast about themselves. (**Jeremiah 4:2**)
