

1 Kings 17:22· Finally Yehowah listened to Elijah's voice, so that the soul of the child came back within him and he came to life.

[20] - References:

- O Hearer of prayer, even to you people of all flesh will come. **(Psalms 65:2)**
- The sacrifice of the wicked ones is something detestable to **Yehowah**, but the prayer of the upright ones is a pleasure to him. **(Proverbs 15:8)**
- But Peter put everybody outside and, bending his knees, he prayed, and, turning to the body, he said; Tabitha, rise! She opened her eyes and, as she caught sight of Peter, she sat up. **(Acts of Apostles 9:40)**
- But he reckoned that God was able to raise him up even from the dead, and from there he did receive him also in an illustrative way. **(Hebrews 11:19)**
- Therefore openly confess **YOUR** sins to one another and pray for one another, that **YOU** may get healed. A righteous man's supplication, when it is at work, has much force. **(James 5:16)**
- **SEE** now that I, I am He, and there are no gods together with me. I put to death, and I make alive. I have severely wounded, and I, I will heal, and there is no one snatching out of my hand. **(Deuteronomy 32:39)**
- **Yehowah** is a Killer and a Preserver of **life**, a Bringer down to Sheol, and He brings up. **(1 Samuel 2:6)**
- Finally he went up and lay down upon the **child** and put his own mouth upon his mouth and his own eyes upon his eyes and his own palms upon his palms and kept bent over him, and gradually the child's flesh grew warm. **(2 Kings 4:34)**
- And it **came** about that as they were burying a man, why, here they saw the marauding band. At once they threw the man into Elisha's burial place and went off. When the man touched the bones of Elisha, he immediately **came to life** and stood upon his feet. **(2 Kings 13:21)**

- **And the dead man sat up and started to speak, and he gave him to his mother. (Luke 7:15)**
- **And her spirit returned, and she rose instantly, and he ordered something to be given her to eat. (Luke 8:55)**
- **Do not marvel at this, because the hour is coming in which all those in the memorial tombs will hear his voice (John 5:28)**
- **The man that had been dead came out with his feet and hands bound with wrappings, and his countenance was bound about with a cloth. Jesus said to them; Loose him and let him go. (John 11:44)**
- **Giving her his hand, he raised her up, and he called the holy ones and the widows and presented her alive. (Acts of Apostles 9:41)**
- **But Paul went downstairs, threw himself upon him and embraced him and said; STOP raising a clamor, for his soul is in him. (Acts of Apostles 20:10)**
- **For to this end Christ died and came to life again, that he might be Lord over both the dead and the living. (Romans 14:9)**
- **And no day has proved to be like that one, either before it or after it, in that Yehowah listened to the voice of a man, for Yehowah himself was fighting for Israel. (Joshua 10:14)**
- **And Elijah the Tishbite from the inhabitants of Gilead proceeded to say to Ahab; As Yehowah the God of Israel before whom I do stand is living, there will occur during these years neither dew nor rain, except at the order of my word! (1 Kings 17:1)**
- **Why is it judged unbelievable among you men that God raises up the dead? (Acts of Apostles 26:8)**
- **Women received their dead by resurrection, but other men were tortured because they would not accept release by some ransom, in order that they might attain a better resurrection. (Hebrews 11:35)**
