

1 Kings 18:19 And now send, collect together all Israel to me at Mount Carmel and also the four hundred and fifty prophets of Baal and the four hundred prophets of the sacred pole, who are eating at the table of Jezebel.

[18] - References:

- And Allammelech and Amad and Mishal. And it reached westward to **Carmel** and to Shihor-libnath. (**Joshua 19:26**)
- And he kept going from there to **Mount Carmel**, and from there he returned to Samaria. (**2 Kings 2:25**)
- As I am alive, is the utterance of the King, whose name is Yehowah of armies; like Tabor among the mountains and like **Carmel** by the sea he will come in. (**Jeremiah 46:18**)
- And he proceeded to say; Yehowah, out of Zion he will roar, and out of Jerusalem he will give forth his voice, and the pasture grounds of the shepherds must go to mourning, and the summit of **Carmel** must dry up. (**Amos 1:2**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Woe to the stupid **prophets**, who are walking after their own spirit, when there is nothing that they have seen! (**Ezekiel 13:3**)
- And Ahab went on to make the **sacred pole**, and Ahab came to do more to offend Yehowah the God of **Israel** than all the kings of **Israel** that happened to be prior to him. (**1 Kings 16:33**)
- Then Ahab told **Jezebel** all that Elijah had done and all about how he had killed all the **prophets** with the sword. (**1 Kings 19:1**)
- However, the prophet who presumes to speak in my name a word that I have not commanded him to speak or who speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet must die. (**Deuteronomy 18:20**)
- And it came about that, as if it were the most trivial thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, he now took as wife **Jezebel** the daughter of Ethbaal the king of the Sidonians and began to go and serve **Baal** and to bow down to him. (**1 Kings 16:31**)

- So the king of **Israel** collected the **prophets together**, about **four hundred** men, and said to them; Shall I go against Ramoth-gilead in war, or shall I refrain? And they began to say; Go up, and Yehowah will give it into the king's hand. (**1 Kings 22:6**)
- And Elisha proceeded to say to the king of **Israel**; What do I have to do with you? Go to the **prophets** of your father and to the **prophets** of your mother. But the king of **Israel** said to him; No, for Yehowah has called these three kings to give them into the hand of Moab. (**2 Kings 3:13**)
- At once Jehoram made a turn with his hands, that he might flee, and said to Ahaziah; There is trickery, Ahaziah! (**2 Kings 9:23**)
- Moreover, Jehu went on to strike down all who were left over of the house of Ahab in Jezreel and all his distinguished men and his acquaintances and his priests, until he had let no survivor of his remain. (**2 Kings 10:11**)
- So the king of **Israel** collected the **prophets together**, **four hundred** men, and said to them; Shall we go against Ramoth-gilead in war, or shall I refrain? And they began to say; Go up, and the true God will give it into the king's hand. (**2 Chronicles 18:5**)
- The watchman of Ephraim was with my God. As regards a prophet, there is the trap of a birdcatcher on all his ways, there is an animosity in the house of his God. (**Hosea 9:8**)
- They called them. To that same extent they went away from before them. To the **Baal** images they took up sacrificing, and to the graven images they began making sacrificial smoke. (**Hosea 11:2**)
