[5] - References:

- At this she said; As Yehowah your God is living, I have no **round cake**, but a handful of flour in the large jar and a little oil in the small jar, and here I am gathering up a few pieces of wood, and I must go in and make something for myself and my son, and we shall have to **eat** it and die. (**1 Kings 17:12**)
- He is the one that will reside on the heights themselves; his secure height will be craggy places difficult to approach. His own bread will certainly be given him, his **water** supply will be unfailing. (**Isaiah 33:16**)
- This thing that you have done is not good. As Yehowah is living, **YOU** men deserve to die, because **YOU** have not watched over **YOUR** lord, over the anointed of Yehowah. And now see where the king's spear and the **water jug** are that were at his head. (**1 Samuel 26:16**)
- However, when they disembarked onto land they beheld lying there a charcoal fire and fish lying upon it and bread. (**John 21:9**)
- And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and sixty days. (**Revelation 12:6**)
