- **Thirty years old was David when he became king. For forty years he ruled as king. (2 Samuel 5:4)**
- **And the days that David had reigned over Israel were forty years. In Hebron he had reigned seven years, and in Jerusalem he had reigned thirty-three years. (1 Kings 2:11)**
- **And David himself had grown old and satisfied with days, and so he made Solomon his son king over Israel. (1 Chronicles 23:1)**
- **And the days that he reigned over Israel were forty years. In Hebron he reigned for seven years, and in Jerusalem he reigned for thirty-three years. (1 Chronicles 29:27)**
- **In themselves the days of our years are seventy years, and if because of special mightiness they are eighty years, yet their insistence is on trouble and hurtful things, for it must quickly pass by, and away we fly. (Psalms 90:10)**
