- As for **Zadok** the **priest** and **Benaiah** the **son** of Jehoiada and **Nathan** the **prophet** and Shimei and Rei and the mighty **men** that belonged to **David**, they did not become involved with Adonijah. (**1 Kings 1:8**)
- And Joab was over all the army of Israel, and **Benaiah** the **son** of Jehoiada was over the Cherethites and over the Pelethites. (**2 Samuel 20:23**)
- As for **Benaiah** the **son** of Jehoiada the **son** of a valiant man, who did many deeds in Kabzeel, he himself struck down the two **sons** of Ariel of Moab, and he himself descended and struck down a lion inside a waterpit on a day of snowfall. (**2 Samuel 23:20**)
- The chief of the third service group for the third month was **Benaiah** the **son** of Jehoiada the chief **priest**, and in his division there were twenty-four thousand. (**1 Chronicles 27:5**)
- As for the rest of the affairs of Solomon, the first and the last, are they not written among the words of **Nathan** the **prophet** and in the prophecy of Ahijah the Shilonite and in the record of visions of Iddo the visionary concerning Jeroboam the **son** of Nebat? (**2 Chronicles 9:29**)
