- At that Jezebel **sent** a messenger to Elijah, saying; **So** may the **gods** do, and so may they **add** to it, if at this time tomorrow I shall not make your soul like the soul of each one of them! (**1 Kings 19:2**)
- How can I forgive you for this very thing? Your own sons have left me, and they keep swearing by what is no God. And I kept satisfying them, but they continued committing adultery, and to the house of a prostitute woman they go in troops. (**Jeremiah 5:7**)
- Now when it became day, the Jews formed a conspiracy and bound themselves with a curse, saying they would neither eat nor drink until they had killed Paul. (**Acts of Apostles 23:12**)
- Pride is before a crash, and a haughty spirit before stumbling. (**Proverbs 16:18**)
- By means of your servants you have taunted Yehowah and you say; `with the multitude of my war chariots I myself; I shall certainly ascend the height of mountainous regions, the remotest parts of Lebanon, and I shall cut down its lofty cedars, its choice juniper trees.
