- And, look! A certain prophet approached Ahab the king of Israel and then said; This is what Yehowah has said; Have you seen all this great crowd? Here I am giving it into your hand today, and you will certainly know that I am Yehowah. (1 Kings 20:13)

- And it came about at the time of the year's return, at the time that kings sally forth, that Joab proceeded to lead the combat force of the army and lay the land of the sons of Ammon in ruin and to come and besiege Rabbah, while David was dwelling in Jerusalem, and Joab went on to strike Rabbah and throw it down. (1 Chronicles 20:1)

- **And at the **return** of the **year** King Nebuchadnezzar sent and proceeded to bring him to Babylon with desirable articles of the house of Yehowah. Further, he made Zedekiah his father's brother **king** over Judah and Jerusalem. (2 Chronicles 36:10)**
- **And it came about at the turn of the **year** a military force of **Syria** came up **against** him, and they began to invade Judah and Jerusalem. Then they brought all the princes of the people to ruin from among the people, and all their spoil they sent to the **king** of Damascus. (2 Chronicles 24:23)**
