

1 Kings 2:10 Then David lay down with his forefathers and was buried in the City of David.

- And gradually he died in a good old age, satisfied with days, riches and glory, and Solomon his son began to reign in place of him. (**1 Chronicles 29:28**)
- Man, born of woman, is short-lived and glutted with agitation. (**Job 14:1**)
- Also, they have become afraid merely at what is high, and there are terrors in the way. And the almond tree carries blossoms, and the grasshopper drags itself along, and the caper berry bursts, because man is walking to his long-lasting house and the wailers have marched around in the street. (**Ecclesiastes 12:5**)
- For **David**, on the one hand, served the express will of God in his own generation and fell asleep in death and was laid with his **forefathers** and did see corruption. (**Acts of Apostles 13:36**)
- Just the same, **David** proceeded to capture the stronghold of Zion, that is, the **City of David**. (**2 Samuel 5:7**)
- And Solomon proceeded to form a marriage alliance with Pharaoh the king of Egypt and to take Pharaoh's daughter and bring her to the **City of David**, until he finished building his own house and the house of Yehowah and Jerusalem's wall all around. (**1 Kings 3:1**)
- Then Solomon **lay down** with his **forefathers**, and was **buried** in the **City of David** his father, and Rehoboam his son began to reign in place of him. (**1 Kings 11:43**)
- And **David** took up dwelling in the place difficult to approach. That is why they called it the **City of David**. (**1 Chronicles 11:7**)
- Men, brothers, it is allowable to speak with freeness of speech to **you** concerning the family head **David**, that he both deceased and was **buried** and his tomb is among us to this day. (**Acts of Apostles 2:29**)

- And it will certainly occur that as soon as my lord the king lies **down** with his **forefathers**, I myself and also my son Solomon shall certainly become offenders. (**1 Kings 1:21**)
- And Hadad himself heard in Egypt that **David** had lain **down** with his **forefathers** and that Joab the chief of the army had died. So Hadad said to Pharaoh; Send me away, that I may go to my own land. (**1 Kings 11:21**)
- Finally Jehoshaphat **lay down** with his **forefathers** and was **buried** with his **forefathers** in the **City of David** his forefather, and Jehoram his son began to reign in place of him. (**1 Kings 22:50**)
- Finally Jehoram **lay down** with his **forefathers** and was **buried** with his **forefathers** in the **City of David**. And Ahaziah his son began to reign in place of him. (**2 Kings 8:24**)
- So they carried him upon horses and he was **buried** in Jerusalem with his **forefathers** in the **City of David**. (**2 Kings 14:20**)
- Finally Hezekiah **lay down** with his **forefathers**, and Manasseh his son began to reign in place of him. (**2 Kings 20:21**)
- Finally Manasseh **lay down** with his **forefathers** and was **buried** in the garden of his house, in the garden of Uzza, and Amon his son began to reign in place of him. (**2 Kings 21:18**)
- And the inhabitants of Jebus began to say to **David**; You will not come in here. Just the same, **David** proceeded to capture the stronghold of Zion, that is to say, the **City of David**. (**1 Chronicles 11:5**)
- And it must occur that when your days have come to the full for you to go to be with your **forefathers**, I shall certainly raise up your seed after you that will come to be one of your sons, and I shall indeed firmly establish his kingship. (**1 Chronicles 17:11**)
- Finally Solomon **lay down** with his **forefathers**. So they **buried** him in the **City of David** his father, and Rehoboam his son began to reign in place of him. (**2 Chronicles 9:31**)
- Finally Abijah **lay down** with his **forefathers**, and they **buried** him in the **City of David**, and Asa his son began to reign in place of him. In his days the land had no disturbance for ten years. (**2 Chronicles 14:1**)

- **Thirty-two years old he happened to be when he began to reign, and for eight years he reigned in Jerusalem. Finally he went away without being desired. So they buried him in the City of David, but not in the burial places of the kings. (2 Chronicles 21:20)**
- **So they buried him in the City of David along with the kings, because he had done good in Israel and with the true God and His house. (2 Chronicles 24:16)**
- **And when they went away from him, for they left him with many diseases, his own servants conspired against him because of the blood of the sons of Jehoiada the priest, and they got to kill him upon his own couch, so that he died. Then they buried him in the City of David, but they did not bury him in the burial places of the kings. (2 Chronicles 24:25)**
- **So they carried him upon horses and buried him with his forefathers in the city of Judah. (2 Chronicles 25:28)**
- **After him Nehemiah the son of Azbuk, a prince of half the district of Beth-zur, did repair work as far as in front of the Burial Places of David and as far as the pool that had been made and as far as the House of the Mighty Ones. (Nehemiah 3:16)**
- **With kings and counselors of the earth, those building desolate places for themselves. (Job 3:14)**
