- For you constitute him highly **blessed** forever, you make him feel glad with the rejoicing at your face. (**Psalms 21:6**)
- Let his name **prove** to be to time indefinite, **before** the sun let his name have increase, and by means of him let them bless themselves, let all nations pronounce him happy. (**Psalms 72:17**)
- And now, as **Yehowah** is living who has **firmly established** me and keeps me seated upon the **throne** of **David** my father and who made a house for me just as he has spoken, today Adonijah **will** be put to death. (**1 Kings 2:24**)
- Let there be the removing of the wicked one **before** the king, and his **throne will** be **firmly established** by righteousness itself. (**Proverbs 25:5**)
- To the abundance of the princely rule and to peace there **will** be no end, upon the **throne** of **David** and upon his kingdom in order to establish it **firmly** and to sustain it by means of justice and by means of righteousness, from now on and to time indefinite. The very zeal of **Yehowah** of armies **will** do this. (**Isaiah 9:7**)
