- A wise king is scattering wicked people, and he turns around upon them a wheel. (**Proverbs 20:26**)
- May it whirl back upon the head of Joab and upon the entire house of his father, and **let** there not be cut off from Joab's house a man with a running discharge or a leper or a man taking hold of the twirling spindle or one falling by the sword or one in need of bread! (**2 Samuel 3:29**)
- Then Benaiah the son of Jehoiada went on up and fell upon him and put him to death, and he got to be buried at his own house in the wilderness. (**1 Kings 2:34**)
- A man burdened with the bloodguilt for a soul will himself flee even to the pit. Let them not get hold of him. (**Proverbs 28:17**)
- There is no **peace**, Yehowah has said, for the wicked ones. (**Isaiah 48:22**)
- Then Jesus said to him; Return your sword to its place, for all those who take the sword will perish by the sword. (**Matthew 26:52**)
- And all his sons and all his daughters kept rising up to comfort him, but he kept refusing to take comfort and saying; For I shall **go down** mourning to my son into Sheol! And his father continued weeping for him. (**Genesis 37:35**)
- However, he said; My son will not **go down** with **you** men, because his brother is dead and he has been left by himself. If a fatal accident should befall him on the way on which **you** would **go**, then **you** would certainly bring **down** my **gray hairs** with grief to **Sheol**. (**Genesis 42:38**)
- The cloud certainly comes to its end and goes away, so he that is going **down** to **Sheol** will not come up. (**Job 7:9**)

- **And the sea gave up those dead in it, and death and Hades gave up those dead in them, and they were judged individually according to their deeds. (Revelation 20:13)**
- **And I today am weak although anointed as king, and these men, the sons of Zeruah, are too severe for me. May Yehowah repay the doer of what is bad according to his own badness. (2 Samuel 3:39)**
- **All that your hand finds to do, do with your very power, for there is no work nor devising nor knowledge nor wisdom in Sheol, the place to which you are going. (Ecclesiastes 9:10)**
