

1 Kings 7:23 And he proceeded to make the molten sea ten cubits from its one brim to its other brim, circular all around, and its height was five cubits, and it took a line of thirty cubits to circle all around it.

[13] - References:

- You must **make** a basin of copper and its stand of copper for washing, and you must put it between the tent of meeting and the altar and put water into it. (**Exodus 30:18**)
- Then he made the basin of copper and its stand of copper, by the use of the mirrors of the women servants who did organized service at the entrance of the tent of meeting. (**Exodus 38:8**)
- And the pillars of copper that were in the house of Yehowah, and the carriages and the copper **sea** that were in the house of Yehowah, the Chaldeans broke in pieces and went carrying the copper of them to Babylon. (**2 Kings 25:13**)
- And the copper pillars that belonged to the house of Yehowah and the carriages and the copper **sea** that was in the house of Yehowah the Chaldeans broke to pieces and went carrying all the copper of them to Babylon. (**Jeremiah 52:17**)
- And he proceeded to **make** the **molten sea ten cubits** from its one **brim** to its other **brim, circular all around**, and its **height** was **five cubits**, and it **took** a **line** of **thirty cubits** to **circle** all **around** it. (**2 Chronicles 4:2**)
- And the one **sea** and the twelve bulls beneath the **sea**. (**1 Kings 7:44**)
- Furthermore, King Ahaz cut the sidewalls of the carriages in pieces and removed from off them the basins, and the **sea** he **took** down off the copper bulls that were underneath it and then put it upon a stone pavement. (**2 Kings 16:17**)
- And from Tibhath and Cun, cities of Hadadezer, David **took** very much copper. With it Solomon made the copper **sea** and the pillars and the copper utensils. (**1 Chronicles 18:8**)
- The one **sea** and the twelve bulls under it. (**2 Chronicles 4:15**)

- **For this is what Yehowah of armies has said concerning the pillars and concerning the sea and concerning the carriages and concerning the remainder of the utensils that are remaining over in this city. (Jeremiah 27:19)**
- **And the two pillars, the one sea, and the twelve copper bulls that were under the sea, the carriages, that King Solomon had made for the house of Yehowah. There happened to be no weight taken of the copper of them, all these articles. (Jeremiah 52:20)**
- **And before the throne there is, as it were, a glassy sea like crystal. And in the midst of the throne and around the throne there are four living creatures that are full of eyes in front and behind. (Revelation 4:6)**
- **And I saw what seemed to be a glassy sea mingled with fire, and those who come off victorious from the wild beast and from its image and from the number of its name standing by the glassy sea, having harps of God. (Revelation 15:2)**
