

**1 Kings 7:41**· The two pillars and the bowl-shaped capitals that were upon the top of the two pillars, and the two networks to cover the two round capitals that were upon the top of the pillars.

- Then he cast the **two pillars** of copper, eighteen cubits being the height of each pillar, and a string of twelve cubits would measure around each of the **two pillars**. (**1 Kings 7:15**)
- The **two pillars** and the **round capitals** upon the **top** of the **two pillars** and the **two networks** to **cover** the **two round capitals** that were upon the **top** of the **pillars** (**2 Chronicles 4:12**)
- There were nets in network, twisted ornaments in chainwork, for the **capitals** that were upon the **top** of the **pillars**, seven for the one capital, and seven for the other capital. (**1 Kings 7:17**)
