- He now made the altar of incense out of acacia wood. A cubit was its length and a cubit its width, it being foursquare, and two cubits was its height. Its horns proceeded out of it. (**Exodus 37:25**)
- And he proceeded to make the table of acacia wood. Two cubits was its length, and a cubit its width, and a cubit and a half its height. (**Exodus 37:10**)
- And Solomon proceeded to make all the utensils that were at the house of the true God and the golden altar and the tables with the showbread upon them. (**2 Chronicles 4:19**)
- And you must place them in two sets of layers, six to the layer set, upon the table of pure gold before Yehowah. (**Leviticus 24:6**)
- And Solomon went on to overlay the house inside with pure gold, and to make chainwork of gold pass across in front of the innermost room, and to overlay it with gold. (**1 Kings 6:21**)
- Then he brought out from there all the treasures of the house of Yehowah and the treasures of the king's house, and went on to cut to pieces all the gold utensils that Solomon the king of Israel had made in the temple of Yehowah, just as Yehowah had spoken. (**2 Kings 24:13**)
- And for the incense altar refined gold by weight and for the representation of the chariot, namely, the cherubs of gold for spreading their wings out and screening over the ark of the covenant of Yehowah. (**1 Chronicles 28:18**)
- And they came bringing up the Ark and the tent of meeting and all the holy utensils that were in the tent. The priests the Levites brought them up. (**2 Chronicles 5:5**)
- After that they came inside to Hezekiah the king and said; We have cleansed the whole house of Yehowah, the altar of burnt

- offering and all its **utensils**, and the **table** of the layer bread and all its **utensils**. (**2 Chronicles 29:18**)
- Is it not Hezekiah himself that removed his high places and his **altars** and then said to Judah and to Jerusalem; Before one **altar** **you** should bow and upon it **you** should make sacrificial smoke? (**2 Chronicles 32:12**)
 - The wooden **altar** was three cubits high, and its length was two cubits, and it had its corner posts. And its length and its walls were of wood. And he proceeded to speak to me; This is the **table** that is before Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 41:22**)
